ATTACHMENT A

PLAN OF DISTRIBUTION OF ASSETS OF FLORIDA COUNCIL FOR VISION AWARENESS, INC.

The following plan of distribution of assets was recommended by a resolution of the Board of Directors, and approved by the membership, of the Florida Council for Vision Awareness, Inc.:

- 1. All liabilities and obligations of the corporation shall be paid and discharged prior to the effective date of the corporation's dissolution.
- 2. Any assets held by the corporation upon condition requiring return, transfer, or conveyance by reason of the corporation's dissolution, shall be returned, transferred, or conveyed in accordance with such requirements prior to the effective date of the corporation's dissolution.
- 3. Those assets held by the corporation in the form of certificates of deposit shall be distributed to the Florida Optometric Association, Inc., a Florida registered not for profit corporation, for the purpose of funding educational programs offered, or sponsored, by the Florida Optometric Association, Inc. Any membership dues received by the corporation after the effective date of the corporation's dissolution shall be transferred to the Florida Optometric Association, Inc., for the specific purpose of funding the continued administration of the *Scholarship Fund* previously established by the corporation.
- 4. Consistent with the corporation's by-laws, all other remaining assets, if any, shall be distributed to the Florida Optometric Association Charities, Inc., a Florida registered not for profit corporation, holding a federal income tax exemption under Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.
- 5. Consistent with the corporation's by-laws, no part of the corporation's assets shall be distributed to members of the corporation.
