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AMENDED AND RESTATED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF

State of the same THE ANCHORAGE AT BONITA BAY PROPERTY OWNERS' ASSOCIATION, INC. (A Florida Corporation Not For Profit)

RECITALS

- Substantial changes have been made to the Articles of Incorporation of THE ANCHORAGE AT BONITA BAY PROPERTY OWNERS' ASSOCIATION, INC. (the "Association"). Refer to the Articles of Incorporation of the Association recorded in Official Records Book 2242, Page 127 et seq., of the Public Records of Lee County, Florida (the "Prior Articles"), for the original text being revised and replaced by the Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation that follow.
- The Prior Articles of the Association were filed with the Secretary of State of Florida on July 15, В. 1991, and assigned document number N44275.
- Ç. The Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation of the Association that follow (the "Articles"), contain extensive amendments and restatements to the Prior Articles requiring approval of the Members of the Association. The Board of Directors of the Association unanimously proposed and approved these Articles on May 24, 2017. These Amended and Rested Articles were adopted and approved by the Members of the Association at a duly called and noticed special meeting of the Members at which a quorum was present on October 18, 2017, adjourned to and reconvened on October 20, 2017, and the number of votes cast for these Articles was sufficient for approval.
- These Articles shall become effective upon filing with the Florida Department of State. Upon D. such filing, these Articles shall amend, restate and replace the Prior Articles in their entirety.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Association hereby amends, restates and replaces the Prior Articles as follows:

ARTICLE I - Name

The name of the corporation is THE ANCHORAGE AT BONITA BAY PROPERTY OWNERS' ASSOCIATION, INC. (the "Corporation" or "Association").

ARTICLE II - Purpose

The purpose for which the Corporation is organized is to act as the governing homeowners' association of THE ANCHORAGE AT BONITA BAY, a residential community located in Lee County, Florida, pursuant to the Homeowners' Association Act, Chapter 720, Florida Statutes, as it hereafter may be amended.

ARTICLE III - Membership

The qualification of Members in the Association and the manner of their admission shall be as follows: Any person or persons or entity that hold(s) record title in fee simple to a Lot (unit) in THE ANCHORAGE AT BONITA BAY community shall, by virtue of such ownership and upon submission of such Lot to the Declaration (hereinafter defined), automatically be a Member of the Corporation.

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ARTICLE IV - Duration

The Corporation shall exist perpetually.

ARTICLE V - Subscriber

ARTICLE VI - Principal Office; Registered Agent Name and Address

The principal office address, mailing address and street address of the registered office of the Corporation is 8910 Terrene Court, Suite 200, Bonita Springs, FL 34135, or at such other place as may be subsequently designated by the Board of Directors. The name of the registered agent is GULF BREEZE MANAGEMENT, INC., and the street address of the registered agent is 8910 Terrene Court, Suite 200, Bonita Springs, FL 34135, or such other registered agent and at such other place as may be subsequently designated by the Board of Directors.

<u>ARTICLE VII – Board of Directors</u>

The affairs of the Corporation are to be managed by a Board of Directors of not less than three (3) or more than seven (7) persons. The number of Directors may be increased or decreased by the Board of Directors from time to time, but a decrease in the number of Directors shall not reduce the term of office for a seated Director. Directors will be elected each year at the annual meeting of the Members of the Corporation, or at any other meeting or by any other method, each as provided for in the Bylaws of the Corporation. A Director must be a Member of the Association.

ARTICLE VIII - Officers

ARTICLE X - Bylaws

The Bylaws of the Corporation are to be made, altered or rescinded as provided for in the Bylaws of the Corporation.

ARTICLE XI - Amendment

Amendments to these Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation may be proposed and adopted at any regular or specially called meeting of the Members of the Association by a majority vote of all the Members. Due notice of the meeting must be given as provided for in the Bylaws of the Corporation.

ARTICLE XII - Membership Vote

Each Lot (unit) in THE ANCHORAGE AT BONITA BAY shall have one (1) full, indivisible Membership vote. If there is more than one (1) owner with respect to a Lot as a result of the fee simple interest in such Lot being held by more than one (1) person or entity, such owners, collectively, shall be entitled to only one (1) vote in the manner determined by the Declaration and Bylaws of the Corporation.

ARTICLE XIII - Corporation Not For Profit

The Corporation is a corporation not for profit under Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, as it hereafter may be amended, and is not formed for pecuniary profit. No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of or be distributable to any Member, person or entity (except that reasonable

compensation may be paid for services rendered to or for the Corporation, and reasonable expenses may be paid thereto, affecting one or more of the Corporation's purposes), or through the rebate of the excess membership dues, fees or assessments to the extent permitted by Florida Statutes as they hereafter may be amended. No Member or any private individual shall be entitled to share in the distribution of any of the corporate assets on the dissolution of the Corporation.

ARTICLE XIV - Indemnification

Each Director and Officer of the Corporation now or hereafter serving as such, shall be indemnified by the Corporation against any and all claims and liabilities to which such Director or Officer has or shall become subject by reason of serving or having served as such Director or Officer, or by reason of any action alleged to have been taken, omitted or neglected by him or her as such Director or Officer. The Corporation shall reimburse each such person for all legal expenses reasonably incurred by them in connection with any such claim or liability, provided, however, that no such person shall be indemnified against or be reimbursed for any expense incurred in connection with, any claim or liability arising out of such Director's or Officer's willful misconduct or intentional tort.

The right of indemnification hereinabove provided for shall not be exclusive of any rights to which any Director or Officer of the Corporation may otherwise be entitled by law, and the Corporation shall indemnify each such Director and Officer to the full extent permitted by law.

ARTICLE XV - Interpretation

In the event of a conflict between or among the provisions of the Declaration of Restrictive Covenants, Conditions, Restrictions and Easements for the Anchorage at Bonita Bay, as it hereafter may be amended (the "Declaration"), these Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation and the Bylaws of the Corporation, the provisions of the Declaration shall control. In the event of a conflict between the provisions of these Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation and the Bylaws of the Corporation, the provisions of these Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation shall control.
