Plan of Distribution of Assets Neighborhood Enterprise Foundations, Inc.

This Plan of Distribution of Assets (the "Plan") shall govern the liquidation of all assets and the payment of all liabilities of Neighborhood Enterprise Foundation, Inc. (NEFI), a Florida non-profit corporation (the "Corporation").

- 1. All liabilities and obligations of the Corporation will be paid and discharged on or before May 31, 2014, or adequate provisions shall be made for payment during the winding up period pursuant to approval procedures in accordance with Florida law;
- 2. Assets held by the Corporation upon condition requiring return, transfer, or conveyance, which condition occurs by reason of the dissolution, be returned, transferred, or conveyed in accordance with such requirements on or before June, 15, 2014, including the return of furnishings, equipment and records to Escambia County, Florida required for the continuation of various Housing and Community Development Programs previously undertaken by the Corporation;
- 3. Assets received and held by the Corporation subject to limitations permitting their use only for charitable, religious, eleemosynary, benevolent, educational, or similar purposes, but not held upon a condition requiring return, transfer, or conveyance by reason of the dissolution, shall be transferred or conveyed to one or more domestic non-profit corporations, trusts, societies, or organizations engaged in activities substantially similar to those of the dissolving corporation, as provided in the plan of distribution of assets as detailed in Exhibit A;
- 4. Other assets, if any, shall be distributed in accordance with the provisions of the articles of incorporation or the bylaws to the extent that the articles of incorporation or the bylaws provide for distribution to others; and
- 5. Remaining assets, if any, shall be distributed to domestic non-profit corporations, as specified in the Plan of Distribution of Assets.

A copy of the Plan of Distribution of Assets, as formally approval by majority vote of the Board of Directors of the Corporation in a scheduled meeting of the Board and authenticated by execution of President of the Board of Directors, shall be filed with the Florida Department of State on or before May 30, 2014.
