**ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT TO  
ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION  
OF  
APOPKA COALITION TO IMPROVE OUR NEIGHBORHOOD, INC.**

The Articles of Incorporation of APOPKA COALITION TO IMPROVE OUR NEIGHBORHOOD, INC. heretofore approved and filed in the office of the Secretary of State of Florida on April 3, 1992, Document No. N48243, pursuant to Section 617.1006 of the Florida Not For Profit Corporation Act, is hereby amended in the following particulars:

1. Article III, Section 1 of the Articles of Incorporation is amended to read as follows:

"Section 1. Specific Purpose. The specific and primary purposes for which this Corporation is formed are to promote and facilitate charitable activities to improve the economic, public safety, recreational, educational, and social welfare of the impoverished and economically disadvantaged community of South Apopka of Orange County, including without limitation to foster low-income housing."

2. The foregoing amendment was adopted by the directors and members at a meeting held on the 9th day of February, 1998, and the number of votes cast for the amendment was sufficient for approval.

In all other respects, the Articles of Incorporation shall remain as they were prior to this Amendment being adopted.
