## ARTICLES OF DISSOLUTION OF CITRUS-HERNANDO PRIVATE INDUSTRY COUNCIL, INC.

Pursuant to Section 617.1402 of the Florida Statutes, the undersigned Corporation adopts these Articles of Dissolution:

FIRST:

The name of the Corporation is Citrus-Hernando Private Industry Council,

Inc. (CHPIC).

SECOND: The Articles of Incorporation were filed on January 13, 1993 and Articles of Amendment to the Articles of Incorporation were filed on June 16, 1993.

THIRD:

No shares of capital stock have been issued by the Corporation.

FOURTH: The net assets of the Corporation remaining after winding up have been distributed to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious or scientific purposes as qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

FIFTH:

No corporate debts remain unpaid.

SIXTH:

A majority of the directors have elected to have the Corporation dissolved.

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#### PLAN OF LIQUIDATION AND DISTRIBUTION OF ASSETS OF

CITRUS-HERNANDO PRIVATE INDUSTRY COUNCIL, INC.

#### Authorization for Dissolution

1. On the 1216 day of December, 1996, the Board of Directors of the Corporation adopted a resolution that the Corporation be dissolved.

#### Approval and Adoption of the Plan

2. The Board of Directors of the Corporation has determined that it is in the best interests of the Corporation that the liquidation of the Corporation and the distribution of its assets be made pursuant to a formal, written plan of liquidation and distribution, under which Citrus-Hernando Private Industry Council, Inc. (CHPIC) shall be completely liquidated and dissolved, all of its known debts and liabilities shall be paid or otherwise provided for, and all of its remaining property and assets shall be distributed to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious or scientific purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. This plan shall become effective on the date on which it is approved and adopted by the vote or written consent of the Board of Directors. The date of Board approval and adoption of the plan is hereinafter called the "effective date".

#### Cessation of Business

3. The Corporation has already ceased to carry on business, except to the extent necessary to properly wind up its affairs and to preserve the value of its business and assets pending liquidation and distribution.

#### Distribution of Assets and Payments of Debts and Liabilities

4. After the effective date, the Board of Directors and the Officers of the Corporation shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all of the debts and liabilities of the Corporation, dispose of all of the assets of the Corporation exclusively for the purposes of the Corporation and such manner, or to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious or scientific purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. The Board of Directors and the Officers of the Corporation may execute any instruments that are necessary to transfer title to the property and assets.

#### **Powers of Directors and Officers**

5. The Board of Directors and the Officers of the Corporation shall carry out the

provisions of this plan and shall take all actions that are necessary or advisable to effect the complete liquidation of the Corporation and its dissolution, including the execution of all documents required by law to be filed to effect the dissolution of the Corporation.
