ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF

THE DUNBAR FESTIVAL COMMITTEE, INC.

The undersigned subscribers to these Articles of Incorporation, natural persons competent to contract, hereby form a corporation not for profit under the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE I

The names of this corporation is THE DUNBAR FESTIVAL COMMITTEE, INC., a not for profit corporation, and the address of the principal office is 2709 Blake Street, Fort Myers, FL 33916.

ARTICLE II

The general nature of the business operations to be transacted by said corporation shall be as follows:

To foster, support and engage in activities relative to socio-economic development, progress and ideals including any and all activities which are lawful and appropriate in accordance with the laws of the State of Florida; that enhance individual, family and community pride and awareness within Southwest Florida;

To effect positive and social change by emphasizing the importance of education and encouraging and assisting youths to be prepared for college, vocational school or entrepreneurship as they transition into adulthood to enhance their quality of life; To motivate constituents to carry out their civic duties through volunteerism and mentoring;

To engage in any activity permitted under the laws of the United States of America, its territories, districts, and possessions, and any activity permitted under the laws of the State of Florida, and to have, exercise, and enjoy the powers and privileges granted to corporations not-for-profit by Chapter 617, Florida Statutes; and

To do all and everything necessary, suitable and proper, for the accomplishment of any of the purposed of the attainment of any of the objectives, or for the furtherance of the powers herein set forth, either alone or in association with other corporations, firms, or individuals, and to do every other act or acts, thing or things, incidental or appurtenant to or growing out of or connected with the aforesaid business of powers, or any part thereof; provided that the same be not inconsistent with the laws under which this corporation is organized.

<u>ARTICLE III</u>

The purposes for which the Dunbar Festival Committee, Inc. is organized are exclusively charitable, religious, literary and educational purposes, including for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations within the meaning of section 501(c) 3 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE IV

The corporation shall have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE V

Membership shall be open to anyone who has attended three (3) consecutive meetings wishing to devote time and energy in furtherance of the purposes of the corporation. There shall be no membership certificates issued, nor shall there by any shareholders.

<u>ARTICLE VI</u>

The mailing address of the Dunbar Festival Committee is Post Office Box 61141, Fort Myers, FL 33906-1141, and the name of the agent shall be the president of the corporation.

The Corporation is empowered:

- (a) To buy, own, sell, convey, assign, mortgage or lease any interest in real estate and personal property and to construct, maintain and operate improvements thereon necessary or incident to the accomplishment of the purposes set forth in Article IV hereof.
- (b) To borrow money and issue evidence of indebtedness in furtherance of any or all of the objects of its business, and to secure the same by mortgage, pledge or other lien on the corporation's property.
- (c) To do and perform all acts reasonably necessary to accomplish the purposes of the Corporation.
- (d) In the event of dissolution, winding up, or other liquidation of the assets of this Corporation, the residual assets of the Corporation will be turned over to one or more organizations which themselves are exempt as organizations described in Section 501 (c) (3) and 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or corresponding sections of any future law, or to the Federal, State or local government for exclusive public purpose.
- (e) Notwithstanding any other provisions of these Articles, this Corporation will not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by: (a) a corporation exempt from Federal Income Tax under Section 501 (c) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law; or (b) a corporation, contributions

to which are deductible under Section 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, or any other corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.
