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

ACCOUNTIBILITY AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE OFFICERS OF IFNA

PRESIDENT

The President shall be accountable and have overall responsibility in fulfilling the Global mission of IFNA. He or she may change and update the Global mission of IFNA as needed and subject to the approval of the Executive Committee. He or she is:

- Responsible in structuring all legal documents with respect to the operational procedures of IFNA, establishing IFNA centers around the Globe along with their responsibilities and commitment to the Headquarter of IFNA,
- To appoint various committees as needed, responsible with developing all communication procedures and strategies of IFNA,
- To develop a procedure of identifying the best possible countries to hold the World Congress of IFNA, and develop promotional strategies, etc.

The President shall have such other powers and duties as may be described by the By-Laws of IFNA. He or she shall, whenever it may be in his opinion be necessary, to modify the duties of other officers or employees of IFNA, in a manner not consistent with the provisions of IFNA By-Laws and the Board of Directors. The President is to seek approval of all his actions concerning his or her responsibilities to IFNA from the Executive Committee. In case of a tie vote, the subject matter will be brought to the Board of Directors for their approval or disapproval.

VICE PRESIDENT

In the absence or disability of the President, the Vice President shall perform all duties of the President, and when so acting he or she shall have all the powers and responsibilities of the President and be subject to all the restrictions on the President of IFNA. If at any such time the Corporation has more than one Vice President, some duties and powers of the President shall be passed on to the most Senior Vice Presidents of IFNA that is in order of their rank as determined by the Executive Committee, or if they are not so ranked, to the Vice President designated by the Executive Committee. The Vice President shall have such other powers and perform such other duties as may be prescribed for them from time to time by the President or the By-Laws of IFNA.

SECRETARY

- A) Certify the original or a copy of its Articles of Incorporation and By-laws, as amended or otherwise altered to date.
- B) Process to the State of Florida, Division of Corporations any change in the structure of the By-Laws of IFNA.
- C) See that all of the notices are duly given in accordance with the provisions of the IFNA By-Laws or as required by law/ regulation/ procedure.
- D) Be custodian of the records and of the seal of the Corporation and see that it is engraved, lithographed, printed, stamped, impressed upon, or affixed to all documents the execution of which on behalf of the Corporation under its seal is duly authorized in accordance with the provisions of these By-Laws.
- E) Keep at the principal office of the corporation or such other place as the Executive Committee may direct: (i) the original or a copy of its Articles of Incorporation and By-laws, as amended or otherwise altered to date, (ii) a book of minutes of the Executive Committee meetings and all of the Board of Directors meetings of IFNA, with the time and place of holding, whether regular or special, and (iii) if it is special meeting, then how it was authorized, the notice thereof give, and the names of those present at the meetings.
- F) See that the books, reports, statements, and all other documents and records required by law are properly kept and filed.
- G) Exhibit at all reasonable times to any Executive Committee upon application, the By-laws and minutes proceeding of the Executive Committee and Board of Directors of IFNA.
- H) In general, perform all duties incident to the office of Secretary, and other such duties as from time to time may be assigned to him or her by the President of IFNA.

TREASURER

- A) Have charge and custody of, and be responsible for, all funds and securities of the Corporation.
- B) deposit all such funds in the name of the Corporation in such banks, trust companies or other depositories as shall be approved by the Executive Committee of IFNA
- C) Keep and maintain adequate and correct accounts of the Corporation's properties and business transactions, including account of its assets, liabilities, receipts, disbursements, gains, losses, capital, and surplus.
- D) Exhibit at all reasonable times the books of account and records to any Executive Committees during business hours at the office of the Corporation where such books and records are kept.
- E) Render a statement of the condition of the finances of the Corporation at all meetings of the Board of Directors of IFNA.
- F) Receive, and give receipt for, moneys due and payable to the Corporation from any source whatsoever.
- G) Responsible of filling all tax documents that are required.
- H) In general, perform all the duties incident to the office of Treasurer and such other duties as from time to time may be assigned to him or her by the President of IFNA.

MINUTES OF MEETING OF IFNA BOARD OF DIRECTORS

3:00 PM, Wednesday, September 17, 2008
Math/Physics Building
Office PHY 363
University of South Florida, Tampa, Florida

The Board of Directors of IFNA met and deliberated in detail, and approved the following items:

- 1. The Board of Directors approved that Dr. V. Lakshmikantham will be listed in all important documents and web-site of IFNA as the Founding President, along with his picture, in perpetuity.
- 2. The Board of Directors approved the "Future Administrative Structure of IFNA" that was presented at the 5th IFNA World Congress in Orlando, FL in July 2008 that was initially approved by Dr. Lakshmikantham.
- 3. There were 17 individuals that where nominated to elect FOUR that will constitute the "Executive Committee of IFNA." The top four (highest approval) where Dr. Tsokos, Dr. Ladde, Dr. Sambandham and Dr. Wooten.

These four individuals were approved by the Board of Directors, and will constitute the "IFNA Executive Committee."

- 4. The Board of Directors empowered the "IFNA Executive Committee" to address and be responsible in every aspect of the objectives and Mission of IFNA. A partial list of the responsibilities include:
 - Make the necessary personnel change to increase the efficiency and effectiveness of the IFNA administration structure
 - develop a procedure for establishing centers in the various countries in the world,
 - · strategies to increase the membership of IFNA and identify the membership benefits
 - establish graduate student membership
 - determine policy for many conferences in several countries,
 - determine the places were the World Congress are to be held (establish criteria),
 - · identify and establish all necessary committees to assist in fulfilling the goals and mission of IFNA
 - update the website consistent with the administrative changes that will be taken place,
 - · establish various international committees to fulfill the purpose and mission of IFNA,
 - etc

- 5. The Board of Directors approved a request that the "IFNA Executive Committee" proceed to establish in writing the responsibilities of each of the four Officers of IFNA; namely, President, Vice President, Treasurer and Secretary, prior to selecting these officers from the elected members (Item 3) of the "IFNA Executive Committee"
- 6. The Board of Directors approved a motion that all members that were nominated for the Executive Committee be appointed to various committees of IFNA in accordance with their interests.
- 7. The Board of Directors approved the establishment of "IFNA Advisory Committee," to advise the IFNA Executive Committee: Dr. Agarwal was nominated and approved to chair this committee. This committee will be composed of 4 or 5 other members that will be appointed to by the Executive Committee.

The Board of Directors meeting was formally terminated at 4:45 PM, Wednesday, September 17, 2008.
