
ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

SOUTH BAY YOUTH LEAGUE PROGRAM, Inc. A FLORIDA NONPROFIT CORPORATION

including Certificate of Adoption





ARTICLE L

NAME

The name of this corporation is SOUTH BAY YOUTH LEAGUE PROGRAM INC.

ARTICLE II. STATEMENT OF CORPORATE NATURE

This is a nonprofit corporation organized solely for general charitable purposes pursuant to the Florida Corporations Not for Profit law set forth in Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes.

ARTICLE III. GENERAL AND SPECIFIC PURPOSES

- (a) The specific and primary purposes for which this corporation is formed are to operate for the advancement and development of children within the community through educational interaction and for other charitable purposes, by the distribution of its funds for such purposes, and particularly for the development of children within South Bay through amateur athletic discipline, training and motivational interactions, along with educational programs in order to enhance the academic, social and civic awareness of the children so that they can become successful students and successful citizens for the community.
- (b) The general purposes for which this corporation is formed are to operate exclusively for such charitable and educational purposes as will qualify it as an exempt organization under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 or corresponding provisions of any subsequent federal tax laws, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations which qualify as tax-exempt organizations under that Code.
- (c) This corporation shall not, as a substantial part of its activities, carry on propaganda or otherwise attempt to influence legislation; nor shall it participate or intervene (by publication or distribution of any statements or otherwise) in any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

ARTICLE IV. TERM

This corporation shall have a perpetual existence.

ARTICLE V. MEMBERSHIP

The corporation shall have a membership distinct from the Board of Directors. The authorized number and qualifications of the members of the corporation, the manner of their admission, the different classes of membership, if any, the property, voting, and other rights and privileges of members, and their liability for dues and assessments and the method of collection thereof, shall be set forth in the bylaws.

ARTICLE VI. LOCATION OF PRINCIPAL OFFICE AND IDENTIFICATION OF REGISTERED AGENT.

- (a) The county in the State of Florida where the principal office for the transaction of the business of this corporation is to be located in the County of Palm Beach. The Current principal office is located at 2800 Ilex Court, South Bay, FL 33493

RESTATED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION SOUTH BAY YOUTH LEAGUE PROGRAM, Inc. A FLORIDA NONPROFIT CORPORATION

ARTICLE VII. MANAGEMENT OF CORPORATE AFFAIRS

(A) Board of Directors. The Powers of this corporation shall be exercised, its properties controlled, and its affairs conducted by a board of directors. The number of directors of the corporation shall be a minimum of THREE (3) provided, however, that such number may be changed by a bylaw duly adopted by the members.

Directors shall serve for a term of two years until the annual meeting of members following the election of Directors and until the qualification of the successors in office. Annual meetings shall be held each year at the principal office of the corporation, or at such other place or places as the board of directors may designate from time to time by resolution.

Any action required or permitted to be taken by the Board of Directors under any provision of law may be taken without a meeting, if all members of the board shall individually or collectively consent in writing to such action. Such written consent or consents shall be filed with the minutes of the proceedings of the board, and any such action by written consent shall have the same force and effect as if taken by unanimous vote of the trustees. Any certificate or other document filed under any provision of law which relates to action so taken shall state that the action was taken by unanimous written consent of the board of trustees without a meeting and that the articles of incorporation and bylaws of this corporation authorize the trustees to so act. Such a statement shall be prima facie evidence of such authority.

(b) Corporate Officers. The Membership shall elect the following officers in accordance with procedures established in the bylaws: president, vice president, treasurer, and secretary. There may exists such other officers as the bylaws of this corporation may authorize the directors to elect from time to time.

ARTICLE VIII BYLAWS.

Subject to the limitations contained in the bylaws, and any limitations set forth in the Corporations Not for Profit law of Florida, concerning corporate action that must be authorized or approved by the members of the corporation, bylaws of this corporation may be made, altered, rescinded, added to or new bylaws may be adopted, either by a resolution of the Board of Directors or by following the procedure set forth therefor in the bylaws.

ARTICLE IX. DEDICATION OF ASSETS

The property of this corporation is irrevocably dedicated to charitable purposes and no part of the net income or assets of this corporation shall ever inure to the benefit of any Director, officer, or member thereof, or to the benefit of any private individual.

ARTICLE X. DISTRIBUTION OF ASSETS

Upon the dissolution or winding up of this corporation, its assets remaining after payment, or provision for payment of all debts and liabilities of the corporation, shall be distributed to a nonprofit fund, foundation, or corporation which is organized and operated exclusively for charitable purposes and which has established its tax exempt status under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, or corresponding provisions of any subsequent federal tax laws.

ARTICLE XI. AMENDMENT OF ARTICLES

Amendments to these articles of incorporation may be adopted by the Board of Directors and may be adopted by the vote of two-thirds of Board of Directors of the corporation.
