TRI-COUNTY CITIZENS AGAINST DISCRIMINATION, INC

Pursuant to the provisions of section 617.1006, Florida Statutes, the undersigned Florida corporation adopts the following articles of amendment to its articles of incorporation.

First: Amendment(s) adopted:

Notwithstanding any other provisions of these articles the corporation is organized exclusively for one or more of the following purpose: religious, charitable, scientific, testing for public safety, literary, or educational purposes, or to foster national or international amateur sports competition (but only if no part of its activities involve the provision of athletic facilities or equipment), or for the prevention of cruelty to children or animals, as specified in section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code and shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt for Federal income tax under section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation (except as otherwise provided by the Internal Revenue Code section 501(h), or participating in, or intervening in, (including the publication or distribution of statements), any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.


Upon dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government , for public purposes. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for charitable purposes.
