AMEND THE FOLLOWING ARTICLES:

**ARTICLE II
PRINCIPAL PLACE OF BUSINESS**

300 South Biscayne River Drive
North Miami, FL 33169

**ARTICLE III
PURPOSE**

The purpose for which Sak Pase Inc. is organized are exclusively religious, charitable, scientific, literary, and educational within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.

**ARTICLE V
LIMITATION OF CORPORATE POWERS**

Notwithstanding, any other provision of these articles, the organization shall carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.

ADD THE FOLLOWING ARTICLES

**ARTICLE VIII
EARNINGS/ASSETS**

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or the corresponding provision of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or a state or a local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed by the Court of Common Pleas of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

ARTICLE IX SELF DEALING

The corporation shall not engage in any act of self dealing as defined in section 4941 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or the corresponding provision of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE X DISTRIBUTION OF INCOME

The corporation will distribute its income for each tax year at a time and in a manner as not to become subject to the tax on undistributed income imposed on section 4942 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or the corresponding provision of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE XI EXCESS BUSINESS

The corporation will not retain any excess business as defined in section 4943 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or the corresponding provision of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE XII INVESTMENTS

The incorporation will not make any investments in a manner as to subject it to tax under section 4944 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or the corresponding provision of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE XIII TAXABLE EXPENDITURES

The corporation shall not make any taxable expenditures as defined in section 4945 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or the corresponding provision of any future federal tax code.
