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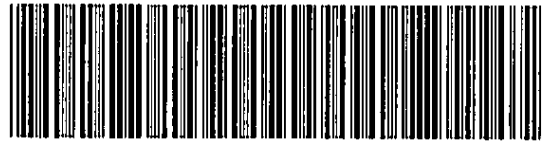

AFTER DISSOLUTION**

The Board of Directors of the Synagogue Council of Sarasota-Manatee, Inc., ("Synagogue Council") a not for profit corporation, has voted to dissolve the corporation and file the requisite documents with the Florida Division of Corporations to effect such dissolution


To that end, the Board of Director, has made a plan for the distribution of its assets upon dissolution, as follows:

1. The Synagogue Council will pay any debts outstanding at the time of the dissolution;
2. The Synagogue Council has surveyed its books and records and finds that it holds no assets loaned to it and therefore does not need to return any assets;
3. The Synagogue Council has approximately \$3200⁰⁰ in funds and upon dissolution, and after payment of any debts it shall distribute the funds equally to the following synagogues, all being 501(c)(3) organizations located in Sarasota or Manatee Counties, Florida:

Congregation Beth El, Bradenton, FL
Congregation Ner Tamid, Bradenton, FL
Temple Sinai, Sarasota, FL
Center for Humanistic Judaism, Sarasota, FL
Congregation Kol Haneshama, Sarasota, FL
Temple Beth Sholom, Sarasota, FL
Temple Emanu-El, Sarasota, FL
Temple Beth Israel, Longboat Key, FL
Jewish Congregation of Venice, Venice, FL

4. The President/Treasurer of the Synagogue Council shall be authorized upon dissolution to make such distributions following dissolution.
