Pursuant to the provisions of section 617.1006, Florida Statutes, the undersigned corporation adopts the following articles of amendment to its articles of incorporation:

Amendment to ARTICLE III Purposes:

The specific purposes for which Calvary Church, Inc., is organized are exclusively religious, charitable, and educational within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.

The purpose of this Church shall be to glorify God through public worship, prayer services, preaching, administering the ordinances, and church school instruction. Through care, concern, and evangelism, this Church will reach out to its community and to the world through its missionary commitments.

An additional corporate purpose of this Church shall be to extend the Word of God through music and the spoken word by means of radio, television, records, tapes, conferences, literature, traveling concerts, home concerts, evangelistic campaigns, and through the use of other similar means.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this organization shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.

If for any reason the Corporation dissolves, after all liabilities are met the remaining assets will be donated to the Lake County Baptist Association of the Florida Baptist Convention.

The amendment was adopted June 1, 1997, in a called meeting of the Board of Directors. There are no members entitled to vote on the amendment.
