ARTICLES OF AMENDEMENT to 20 ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION Of BRASILIAN-AMERICAN HEALTH FOUNDATION, INC.

Pursuant to the provisions of section 617.1006, Florida Statutes, the undersigned Florida nonprofit corporation adopts the following articles of amendment to its articles of incorporation.

FIRST: Amendments adopted:

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation shall be: GETTIN BUSY, INC., (NON-PROFIT CORPORATION).

ARTICLE II

The purposes for which the corporation is organized are to solicit, collect, receive, accumulate, administer, receive and maintain real and personal property, or both, in whatever form, including cash funds from public and private sources, and, subject to the restrictions and limitations hereinafter set forth, to use and apply the whole or any part of the income therefrom, and the principal thereof, exclusively for charitable, literary, scientific or educational purposes either directly or by contributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under 501 (c) 3 of the Internal Revenue Code and the Regulations issued pursuant thereto as they now exist or as they may hereafter be amended.

The Corporation shall be empowered to enter into contracts hold and convey title to real and personal property, and exercise all powers permitted a corporation not for profit under section 617.021, Florida Statutes, and the other laws of the State of Florida, not inconsistent with the general objectives enumerated herein. All funds of the corporation and any monies from its operation shall be used in the furtherance of the purposes set forth herein above.

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributed to, any director or officer of the corporation or any private individual (except that reasonable compensation may be paid for services rendered to or for the corporation in furtherance of one or more of its purposes), and no director or officer of the corporation or any private individual shall be entitled to share in the distribution of any of the corporate assets on dissolution of the corporation. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation and the corporation shall not participate, in , or intervene in (including the publication or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles of incorporation, the corporation shall not conduct or carry on any activities not permitted to be conducted or carried on by an organization exempt from taxation under Section 501 (c) 3 of the Internal Revenue Code and the Regulations issue pursuant thereto as they now exist or as they may hereafter be amended, or by an organization, contribution to which are deductible under Section 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code and said Regulations as they now exist or as they many hereafter be amended.

The corporation shall engage in, promulgate, foster, promote and otherwise cause to be affected the raising of awareness of youth to the problem of HIV in adolescents and young adults, and their communities; educate youth regarding HIV prevention, and to encourage youth to be tested for HIV and to assist those testing postive to be linked to care and treatment.

ARTICLE VIII

The business of this corporation shall be conducted by a Board of Directors, which shall consist of not less than three (3) provided, however, that such number may be changed by the By-Laws duly adopted. The manner in which the directors are to be appointed shall be stated in the By-Laws.
