ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT
to
ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
of

THE OCEANSIDE EVANGELICAL FREE CHURCH OF SATELLITE BEACH, FLORIDA,
INCORPORATED

Pursuant to the provisions of section 617.1006, Florida Statutes,
the undersigned corporation adopts the following articles of
amendment to its articles of incorporation.

FIRST: Amendment adopted

ARTICLE I
PURPOSE\SCOPE

a. The purpose of the church shall be the preaching of
the Word of God to the mutual edification, instruction, and
discipline of its members and other believers, the winning of the
unsaved to Christ, helping young Christians to develop spiritual-
ly, instructing children in the Word of God, carrying on the
ministry of benevolence, and furthering the cause of Christ on
the mission fields at home and abroad.

b. Said corporation is organized exclusively for char-
itable, educational, religious or scientific purposes, within the
meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code (or
corresponding section of any future Federal tax code.)

c. No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall
inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members,
trustees, directors, officers or other private persons, except
that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay
reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make pay-
ments and distributions in furtherance of Section 501(c)(3)
purposes. No substantial part of the activities of the corpora-
tion shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attemp-
ting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not
participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or
distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or
in opposition to any candidate for public office.

d. Notwithstanding any other provision of these
articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities
not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from
Federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Reve-
nue Code (or corresponding section of any future Federal tax
code.)

ARTICLE II

CHURCH PROPERTY

a. In the case of a division of the church, from which God in His Mercy preserve us, the property of the church shall belong to those who abide by the church constitution. In case of dissolution of the church, the property shall automatically become the property of the Evangelical Free Church of America (EFCA) provided said EFCA meets the standards directed by controlling government agencies outlined in paragraph b, following.

b. Upon dissolution of this corporation assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, i.e. charitable, educational, religious or scientific, or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the Federal government, or to a state or local government for a public purpose.

c. The corporation shall be considered dissolved when only five or less members remain.

All previous ordinances and by-laws conflicting with these Articles of Incorporation are hereby annulled.
