ARTICLES OF DISSOLUTION

Pursuant to Section 617.1403, Florida Statutes, this Florida not for profit corporation submits the following Articles of Dissolution:

- FIRST:** The name of the corporation is "Enterprise Florida Jobs And Education Partnership, Inc."
- SECOND:** Enterprise Florida Jobs And Education Partnership, Inc. was a corporation created under the auspices of the Job Training Partnership Act, Pub. L. No. 300. Enterprise Florida Jobs And Education Partnership was designated as the State Human Resource Investment Council pursuant to Section 446.20(2), Florida Statutes, 1997.
- THIRD:** Enterprise Florida Jobs And Education Partnership was redesignated as the workforce development board by s. 112, ch. 96-320. (See footnote #2 following Section 446.601). Section 288.9618(3)(j) designated the workforce development board as the State Human Resource Investment Council, implicitly replacing Enterprise Florida Jobs And Education Partnership and eliminating its authority and responsibilities.
- FOURTH:** With all its powers and responsibilities transferred, Enterprise Florida Jobs And Education Partnership, Inc. disbanded without formerly voting to dissolve. Due to the large number of directors spread over the state and the ever-changing composition of the Board according to statute, it is infeasible to hold another board meeting for the sole purpose of dissolution.
- FIFTH:** Curtis C. Austin was the last president of Enterprise Florida Jobs And Education Partnership, Inc, as identified in the last Uniform Business Report filed. By his signature below, he attests that he has personal knowledge of the affairs of the corporation and states that Enterprise Florida Jobs And Education Partnership was eliminated by an act of the Florida Legislature, that the purposes for which the corporation was created have been transferred to another corporation by act of the Florida Legislature and that the corporation has no authority or responsibilities, no longer functions, and has no assets or debts.

SECTION II The corporation has no members or members with voting rights.
