ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT TO THE ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION 96 DEC 30 PH 2:07 a Florida Charitable Not For Profit Corporation

SECRETARY OF STATE

Pursuant to the provisions of section 617.1002, Florida Statutes, the undersigned charitable not for profit corporation adopts the following Articles of Amendment to its Articles of Incorporation:

- The name of the corporation is The Waldec Education Foundation, Inc.
 - There are no members entitled to vote on the amendment.
- The following amendment to the Articles of Incorporation was adopted on 100, 1996, at a meeting of the board of directors of the corporation. The number of votes was sufficient.
- The Articles of Incorporation of the corporation is amended to add the following Article IX:

ARTICLE IX

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose.
