## ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT TO ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

#### GRACE UNITED COMMUNITY CHURCH, INC.

#### ARTICLE III - PURPOSE

The said organization shall be organized and operated exclusively religious, charitable, cultural, educational and scientific purposes, including for such purposes the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. The organization is formed to engage in any and all lawful activities incidental to the foregoing purposes, except as restricted herein. All organization properties shall be irrevocably dedicated to the charitable purposes described in these articles. The net earnings of the organization will never be permitted to benefit of, or be distributable to its board, officers, or other private individual to any extent except that the organization shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes forth in these articles. No substantial part of the organization's activities will ever consist of providing insurance of a type similar to that provided commercially or of carrying on propaganda or attempting to influence legislation or other aspectts of the political process. The organization will not take part or intervene in any political campaign. In any taxable year in which the corporation is a private foundation as described in IRC 509(a), the organization shall distribute its income for said period at such time and manner as not to subject it to tax under IRC 4942, and the organization shall not (a) engage in any act of selfdealing as defined in IRC 4941(d), retain any excess business holdings as defined in IRC 4943(c), (b) make any investments in such a manner as to subject the organization to tax under IRC 4944, make any taxable expenditures as defined in IRC 4945(d) or corresponding provisions of any subsequent Federal tax laws. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this organization will not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.
