## INTERDENOMINATIONAL MINISTERIAL ALLIANCE HUMAN SERVICES AND DEVELOPMENT, INC. **#N94000005907**

Pursuant to the provisions of section 617.1006, Florida Statutes, the undersigned Florida nonprofit corporation adopts the following articles of amendment to its articles of incorporation.

FIRST: Amendment adopted:

### ARTICLE II NATURE OF BUSINESS

#### Section 1

The purpose of the of this corporation shall be to conduct studies, research, organize promote and operate facilities to effectively provide general health, education and community services to economically deprived people of Pinellas County, Florida regardless of age, sex, race, color, religion or creed.

#### Section 2.

This Corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, educational, religious, or scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of or be distributed to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT: INTERDENOMINATIONAL MINISTERIAL ALLIANCE HUMAN SERVICES AND DEVELOPMENT, INC. and distributions in furtherance of the purpose clause hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

Notwithstanding any other provision of this document, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal Income Tax under Section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code or (b) by a organization contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 or corresponding provision of any future federal tax code.

Upon dissolution of the Corporation, after paying or making provision for the payment of all of the liabilities of the Corporation, assets shall be distributed for more exempt purposes within the meaning of the section 501 (c) (3) of the internal Revenue Code or the corresponding provision of any future federal tax code, or shall shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not disposed of shall be disposed of by the court of common Pleas of the county in which the principal office of the organization is than located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized an operated exclusively for such purposes.

The assets of the Corporation exclusively for the purposes of the corporation in such manner, or to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious, or scientific purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501 (c) (3) of the internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law), as the the Church Council Ministry determine.

Any of such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of common Plead of the County in which the principal office of the Corporation is then located, exclusively for the purposes or to such ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT: INTERDENOMINATIONAL MINISTERIAL ALLIANCE HUMAN SERVICES AND DEVELOPMENT, INC.

organization or organizations, as said shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

SECOND: The date of adoption of the amendment was August 25, 1997.
