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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

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SECRE IARY OF STATE TALLAHASSEE, FLORIDA

The undersigned incorporates for the purpose of forming a corporation under the Florida Not For Profit Corporation Act, hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE_I

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The name of the corporation shall be Central Florida Division of ASSAULT ON ILLITERACY PROCESS, INC.

ARTICLE II

TERM OF EXISTENCE

The term of existence of the corporation is perpetual.

ARTICLE III

PRINCIPAL PLACE OF BUSINESS AND MAILING ADDRESS

ARTICLE IV

PURPOSES

The specific purpose for which the corporation is organized are as follows:

1. To remove the unique "root causes" of illiteracy so massively devastating to all African Americans.

2. AOIP was established initially as a coalition to broaden and engender involvement of <u>all</u> Black/African-American-led organizations in the <u>uplifting-through-</u> <u>education process</u> (through coalescing) that largely had been put in motion by the National Pan-Hellenic Council. The focus of AOIP was on <u>removing the unique "root causes" of</u> <u>illiteracy</u> so massively devastating to all in Black America. 3. When it was discovered over time that the major "root causes" of illiteracy (ie-- lack of self-esteem and self efficiency) were the same for almost all the other "ills" that uniquely beset Black America, the leadership developed-- and broadened its focus on all of its ten Standing Committees toward--what shall be called AOIP's <u>Goals for Year 2000 & Beyond</u> and set forth on reverse of this page.

4. Even though all organizations affiliated with AOIP must serve in a <u>primary leadership way</u> on one of those ten Standing Committees of AOIP, there were three "families" of organizations-- the "Pan-Hellenics," the " Elks" and the "Masons" who, <u>in addition to their regular committee</u> <u>obligations</u>, volunteered to assume the <u>extra</u>ordinary responsibility.

5. These groups have been deemed as having <u>earned</u> some special leadership responsibility within the AOIP Standing Committees.

6. No action shall be engaged in that would appear in any way to be counter to the purposes set forth by the <u>national</u> body that always will have <u>final</u> approval rights in terms of any and all <u>Division</u> action. Further, any and all official AOIP memoranda issued prior to, or after, approval of this document that has bearing of any nature on any aspect of the work of the Division shall be considered as having been read and its intent incorporated within all areas of this document.

Additionally, when the Division is formed, it will recognize the fact that the role of the Interorganizational Lialson Committee in conjunction with the Prince Hall Masonic Grand Masters (who--in combination--have extraordinary remediative authority), is to see that all types of participating organizations are represented equitably and properly on the board and in every other aspect of the Division.

ARTICLE V

MANNER OF ELECTION OF DIRECTORS

The manner in which the directors are elected or appointed is as follows:

The Board of Directors shall consist of not less than five and no more than eleven persons. They shall be elected for a period of one year with no more than fifty (50%) percent being elected at the general election. They must be members of the corporation, and the Board shall elect their own successors, and may succeed themselves in office.
