ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

CALVARY BAPTIST CHURCH OF GAINESVILLE, INC.

The undersigned, desiring to form a non-profit Florida corporation as provided by Chapter 617 Florida Statutes, do hereby declare that the following Articles shall constitute the Charter of said Corporation upon filing and approval of same by the Secretary of State of Florida.

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation shall be Calvary Baptist Church of Gainesville, Inc., located at Gainesville, Florida.

ARTICLE II

The general nature and object of this corporation is to conduct religious worship, instruct both the children, youth and adults in religious faith based on the Holy Bible, the inspired word of God to subscribe to the doctrinal statements of the Baptist Faith and Message as adopted by the Southern Baptist Convention in 1963. To band with others of like faith, to share and spread the good news of salvation to lost mankind. To instruct others in religious, educational, charitable, and benevolent matters and to advance spiritual growth and enlightenment, moral and personal purity among its own members and the people of the community in which it is located; to promote home and foreign missions; and to aid in the spread of the Gospel of Jesus Christ to the ends of the earth; also, to educate, prepare and ordain Christian men and women for the Ministry of the Gospel of Jesus Christ and to educate our children, youth and adults in a manner befitting Christians.

ARTICLE III

Every person who believes in repentance toward God, and faith in Jesus Christ, as Savior and Lord, and who is willing to confess him publicly as Lord and King and follow Him in baptism by immersion, and to observe the ordinances of Christ and to be governed by His laws, is qualified and eligible for membership in this corporation. The manner of admission to membership in said corporation shall be by letter of dismission from other churches of like faith and order and by satisfactory statement of former membership in a Baptist Church, and profession of faith as herein before provided, upon a favorable majority vote of the membership of said corporation present at any meeting of said Church. The present membership of Calvary Baptist Church (unincorporated) and those hereafter admitted to such membership shall constitute the initial membership of this corporation.

ARTICLE IV

This corporation shall have perpetual existence and shall be effective on the filing of these articles.

ARTICLE V

ARTICLE VI

The business affairs of this corporation shall be managed by a Board of Trustees, such management to be subject to the approval of the Church. Said Board shall be composed of not less than three or more than nine and said Board of Trustees shall be elected from and by the membership of said corporation. The terms of the membership of the Trustees should normally be for three years, provided, however, that the initial Board of Trustees should be staggered for membership of 1, 2 and 3 years so that a new trustee will be elected each year. No trustee shall be eligible to succeed himself until after one year off the Board. The length of time for membership on the Trustees and the number of Trustees may be changed from time to time by the corporation as provided in the By-laws. If a trustee resigns or is unable to serve for any reason, he may be removed by majority vote of said corporation and a new Trustee elected as provided by the By-laws. The said Board of Trustees shall appoint from its own membership a Chairman, Vice-Chairman and Secretary. All legal instruments of the corporation shall be signed by said Chairman or Vice-Chairman, sealed with the corporate seal, and attested by said Secretary; or, in such other manner as may be authorized by law. All elections to membership on said Board of Trustees shall be by majority vote of the members of said corporation present at any business meeting of the said corporation.

In addition to said Board of Trustees, said corporation shall have a President, Secretary and Treasurer, and a Body of Deacons of not less than 2 or more than 21 persons to manage the spiritual affairs of the church, and such other officers as may be necessary, and such officers shall be elected by a majority vote of the corporation present at any business meeting of said corporation for such term as the corporation may provide by its By-laws.

ARTICLE VII

ARTICLE VIII

BY-LAWS

The By-Laws of the corporation are to be made, altered or rescinded upon a two-thirds vote of the members and voting at any duly called meeting of the corporation.

ARTICLE IX

CHARTER

The Charter of the corporation may be altered or rescinded upon a 3/4 vote of the members present and voting at a specially called meeting of the corporation. Notification to members will be announced in the two Sunday services prior to the called business meeting.

ARTICLE X

INDEBTEDNESS

The highest amount of indebtedness or liability to which the corporation may, at any time subject itself shall be Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00).

ARTICLE XI

VALUE OF REAL ESTATE

The amount in value of the real estate which the corporation may hold shall be One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00).

ARTICLE XII

MISCELLANEOUS

A. No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall incur to the benefit of or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized

and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article II hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal Income Tax under Section 50(c) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law) or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which deductible under section 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

B. Upon the dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Trustees shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all of the liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all of assets of the corporation, exclusively for the purposes of the corporation to the Florida Baptist Convention which shall be exclusively for religious purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law) and amendments thereto, as the Board of Directors shall determine. Any of such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a court of competent jurisdiction of the County in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such other organizations as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for said purposes.

ARTICLE XIII

RESIDENT AGENT
