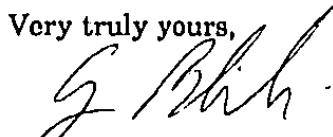

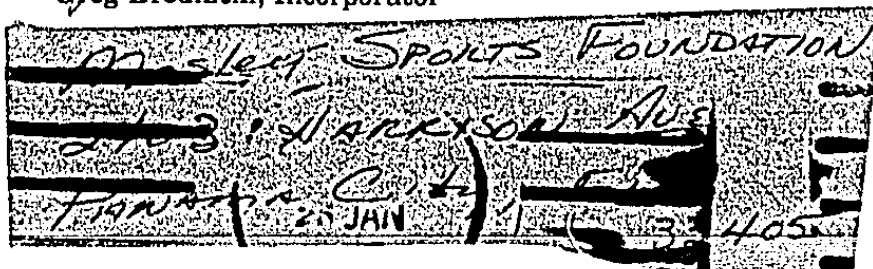

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF

ARTICLE I

The name of this corporation shall be MOSLEY SPORTS FOUNDATION, INC.
It shall be a non-profit corporation organized under the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE II

The primary purpose of this corporation shall be to develop plans and funding to enhance existing athletic facilities and to construct new athletic facilities on the campus of A. Crawford Mosely High School, for any purpose reasonably related thereto in order for the corporation to carry out its mission. This corporation is expressly organized for any lawful purpose within the scope mentioned above not for pecuniary profit as is provided according to Florida F.S. 617.0301, particularly in this case, the purposes of which are charitable, educational, social, and athletic.

ARTICLE III

The street address of the corporation's initial registered office is 2720 Tracy Lane, Panama City, Florida 32405. The street address of the corporation's principal office is 2720 Tracy Lane, Panama City, Florida 32405. The street address of the registered office and business address are the same.

ARTICLE IV

The management of the corporate affairs of this corporation shall be managed by

the Board of Directors. The method of election of the Board of Directors shall be stated in the By-laws of this corporation.

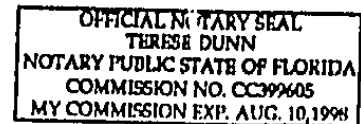

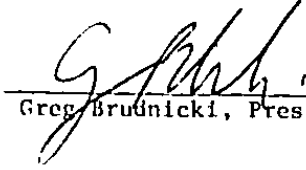
ARTICLE XIII

The purpose for which the corporation is organized are exclusively charitable and educational within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this organization shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law

ARTICLE XII

Upon dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall be determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes
