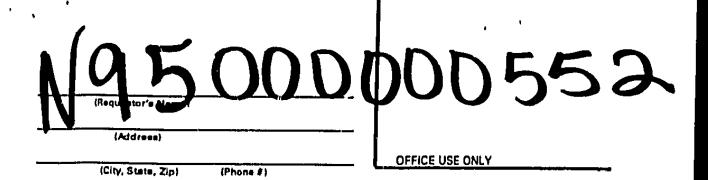

# MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL MEETING OF THE DIRECTORS OF ANCHOR FOUNDATION, INC.

August 15, 1995

- (1) Richard L. Countryman brought to the attention of the Board, that through the oversight of the Board, two items of the Articles of Incorporation needed to be amended. These include:
- A. The purposes for which the Anchor Foundation, Inc. is organized are exclusively charitable within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.
- B. Notwithstanding any other provisions of these articles, this organization shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.
- C. Upon the dissolution of the organization, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.
- (2) Richard L. Countryman motioned that this oversight be corrected by a revised Articles of Incorporation to be handled immediately by Jana Countryman.
- (3) All voting members voted unanimously to approve the Amendments to the Articles of Incorporation and By-laws and authorized filing these Amendments with the State of Florida.

- (4) Recently, Jana Countryman brought before the Board individually, questions by the IRS in seeking the 501(e)(3). These questions were reviewed, answered and final decisions were made by the Board. Some changes were required and these include:
  - A. Make recommended Amendments to the Articles of Incorporation.
  - B. State the month in which your annual accounting period ends: The last day of December.
  - C. To make sure the organization will serve the public modify the Board and submit statements.
