The undersigned, acting as incorporators of a corporation pursuant to chapter 617, Florida Statutes, adopts the following Articles of incorporation:

ARTICLE I NAME

The name of this corporation shall be:

ARTICLE II PRINCIPAL PLACE OF BUSINESS AND MAILING ADDRESS
The principal place of business and the mailing address of this corporation shall be:

ARTICLE III PURPOSES

The specific purposes for which the corporation is organized are:

To promote the post-secondary education of quilified young Americans in their chosen discipline within the fields of science, mathematics, engineering, or law. The awards is to be used by the recipients for tuition and books.

ARTICLE IV MANNER OF ELECTION OF DIRECTORS

The manner in which the directors are elected is as follows: Five Directors (Trustees , shall be elected among the Directors of the Board of Atheists of Florida, Inc, The parent organization, to assume responsibility for the promotion, fund raising and distribution of grants. The term for each Director (Trustee) will be for a term of three (3) years.

ARTICLE V LIMITATION OF CORPORATION POWERS

The corporate powers of the corporation are as provided in section 617.0302, Florida Statutes subsections 1 to 16, with the following limitations:

Subsection 14 to read: Make donations for the public welfare or for charitable, scientific, educational, or other similar purpose, but under no circumstances make donations to any religious or religiously affiliated organization.

Subsection 16 to read: Merge with other corporations both for profit and not for profit, domestic and foreign, if the surviving corporation is a corporation not for profit and its purpose is as specified in Article III of these articles of incorporation or similar.

ARTICLE VI INITIAL REGISTERED AGENT AND STREET ADDRESS

ARTICLE VII DISSOLUTION

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provisions for the payment of all of the liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all of the assets of the corporation exclusively for the purposes of the corporation in such manner, or to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, or scientific purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law,) as the Board of Directors shall determine, but in NO circumstance dispose the assets to any religious, religious affiliated, or other organizations accepting the so called supernatural or spiritual entities.

Any of such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the County in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

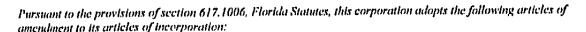
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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

a not-for-profit corporation



ARTICLE III

Pursuant to the requirements of the Department of the Treasury of the United States, Internal Revenue Service, for organizations under Section 501(c) 3 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 the corporation amends Article III of the Articles of Incorporation as follows:

The purpose for which The Mark Twin Scholarship Fund, Inc. is organized are exclusively, charitable, scientific, literary and educational within the meaning of section 501(c)3 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.

ARTICLEIX

Pursuant to the requirements of the Department of the Treasury of the United States, Internal Revenue Service, for organizations under Section 501(e) 3 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 the corporation adds Article 1X to the Articles of Incorporation to read as follows:

Notwithstanding any other provisions of these articles, this organization shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.

Amendments III and IX above were approved by the directors/trustees of The Mark Twin Scholarship Fund, Inc. The number of votes east for the amendments were sufficient for approval. The date of adoption of this amendment is July 28, 1995.

The Mark Twin Scholarship Fund, Inc. has no members. Accordingly, no such vote was required.
