ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF COLLEGE SPORTS PUBLISHERS ASSOCIATION, INC.

A FLORIDA NONPROFIT CORPORATION

ARTICLE ONE. NAME

The name of this corporation is College Sports Publishers Association, Inc.

ARTICLE TWO. STATEMENT OF CORPORATE NATURE AND PURPOSES

This is a nonprofit corporation organized to promote college sports publications with a primary goal of benefiting the entire membership and for any other lawful purpose authorized by the Florida Corporations Not for Profit law set forth in Part I of Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes.
