## ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF A FLORIDA NON-PROFIT CORPORATION



### ARTICLE I NAME OF CORPORATION

The name of the corporation is NORTHSIDE BAT & BALL LITTLE LEAGUE, INC.

### ARTICLE II DURATION

The duration of the Corporation is perpetual.

### ARTICLE III OBJECTIVE

- A. This corporation is a not-for-profit corporation organized under Chapter 617, Florida Statutes. It is not organized for the private gain of any person.
- B. The objective of NORTHSIDE BAT & BALL LITTLE LEAGUE, INC. shall be to implant firmly in the children of the community the ideals of good sportsmanship, honestly, loyalty, courage and respect for authority, so that they may be well adjusted, stronger and happier children and will grow to be good, decent, healthy and trustworthy citizens.
- C. To achieve this objective the NORTHSIDE BAT & BALL LITTLE LEAGUE, INC. will provide a supervised program under the Rules and Regulations of Little League Baseball, Incorporated. All Directors, Officers and Members shall bear in mind that the attainment of exceptional athletic skill or the winning of games is secondary, and the molding of future citizens is of prime importance. In accordance with Section 501(c)(3) of the Federal Internal Revenue Code, the NORTHSIDE BAT & BALL LITTLE LEAGUE, INC. shall operate exclusively as a non-profit educational organization providing a supervised program of competitive baseball and softball games. No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributed to its members, directors, officers, or any other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article Three. No substantial part of the activities the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

### ARTICLE IV MEMBERSHIP

The membership of this corporation shall constitute all persons sincerely interested in active participation to effect the objective set forth in the foregoing Article and such other persons, from time to time hereafter, may become members, in the manner provided in the By-Laws. Member classes and suspension or termination of members shall be as set in the By-Laws.

### ARTICLE V INITIAL REGISTERED AGENT AND OFFICE

The initial registered agent is Lorenzo Williams, Esquire and the initial registered office is 320 South Indian River Drive, Fort Pierce, Florida 34950.

#### ARTICLE VI INITIAL BOARD OF DIRECTORS

- A. The management of the property and affairs of the corporation shall be vested in the Board of Directors. The number of Directors may be raised or lowered by amendment of the By-Laws, but shall in no case be less than three.
- B. The Board of Directors shall be members of the corporation.
- C. Members of the Board of Directors shall be elected and hold office in accordance with the By-Laws.

- B. The local rules of this corporation shall be adopted by the Board of Directors, as established in the By-Laws and shall in no way conflict with the rules, regulations and policies of Little League Baseball, Inc.

### ARTICLE XI DISTRIBUTION OF ASSETS

Upon dissolution of the corporation and after all outstanding debts and claims have been satisfied, the members shall direct the remaining property of the local League to another Federally Incorporated entity which maintains the same objectives are set forth herein, which are or may be entitled to exemption under Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue code or any future corresponding provision.
