## ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF THE SOUTH JACKSONVILLE ROTARY FOUNDATION, INC. A Not For Profit Corporation

#### ARTICLE I Name

The name of this corporation shall be The South Jacksonville Rotary Foundation, Inc. ("the Corporation").

### ARTICLE II Address

The address of the principal office of the Corporation shall be 200 West Forsyth Street, Suite 1020, Jacksonville, Florida 32202. The mailing address of the Corporation shall be the same.

### ARTICLE III Purpose

- (a) The purpose of the Corporation is to promote and finance the charitable projects and assistance to the Jacksonville community undertaken by the Rotary Club of South Jacksonville (the "Club"), to facilitate the Club's goals of service on the local, national and international levels, and for other charitable purposes.
- (b) The Corporation is organized exclusively for charitable and educational purposes within the scope of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, (the Code) and not for pecuniary profit.
- (c) The Corporation shall restrict its activities to the promotion of charitable and educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Code.
- (d) No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members,

directors, officers, or other private persons, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered in furtherance of the purposes set forth herein.

(e) In the event of dissolution of the Corporation for any reason, the Directors shall, after paying the liabilities of the Corporation, distribute all the remaining assets and property of the Corporation exclusively for charitable, coligious, scientific or educational purposes to organizations that are then exempt from taxation under Section 501(c)(3) of the Cook

## ARTICLE IV

The Directors of the Corporation shall consist of the President, President-Elect, Vice President, Treasurer, and Secretary of the Rotary Club of South Jacksonville, and four other directors appointed by the President, who shall be members of the Club Charity Committee. Each director shall serve a one-vear term, from July 1 to June 30. Other provisions governing the election, appointment and service of directors shall be as provided in the By-Laws of the Corporation.

## ARTICLE V Relation to Rotary Club of South Jacksonville

To the extent permitted by Florida law, the Corporation shall be subordinate to and subject to the authority of the officers and directors of the Club, and decisions made by the Board of Directors of the Club shall be binding upon the Corporation.

## ARTICLE 1 Initial Registered Office and Agent

The street address of the initial registered office of this corporation is 200 West Forsyth Street, Suite 1020, Jacksonville, Florida 32202. The name of the initial registered agent of this Corporation at that address is Lee F. Mercier.
