ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

CORNERSTONE BAPTIST CHURCH OF OCALA, INC
(A Corporation Not For Profit)

We, the undersigned, being desirous of forming a corporation for religious purposes, and under the provisions of Chapter 617, of the Florida Statutes, do agree to the following:

ARTICLE I - Name

The name of this corporation is CORNERSTONE BAPTIST CHURCH OF OCALA, INC., and the principal office shall be 3620 Northeast 8th Place, Ocala, Florida 34470.

ARTICLE II - Purposes

The purposes for which the Corporation is formed are as follows:

ARTICLE X

- 1.
