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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

The undersigned, acting as incorporator of this Corporation pursuant to Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes, hereby forms a non-profit Corporation under the laws of the State of Florida and adopts the following Articles of Incorporation for such Corporation:

ARTICLE I: NAME

The name of this Corporation shall be Abuse Recovery Center, Inc.

ARTICLE II: PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The principal office of this Corporation shall be located at 5314-B East Colonial Drive, Orlando, Florida, 32807.

ARTICLE III: PURPOSE
