

ARTICLE I INCORPORATION

The undersigned do hereby associate themselves to establish a non-profit corporation under and within Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, as follows:

ARTICLE II

Name

The name of the corporation shall be Residential Association of Pelican Landing, Inc.

ARTICLE III

Principal place of business and mailing address

The principal place of business and mailing address of this corporation shall be 270 Lakemont Drive, Bonita Springs, FL 33914.

ARTICLE IIII

Purposes

This corporation is organized for the following purposes:

The corporation by this article permanently dedicates its assets to the exempt purposes of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 or the corresponding provision of any prior or future United States Internal Revenue Law. The principal business which shall be carried on at Bonita County, Florida, under the auspices and direction of Residential Association of Pelican Landing, Inc., is to acquire, hold and control such real and personal property as may be necessary, subject only to the limitations of law, for the proper and efficient accomplishment of the foregoing purpose and to pursue these purposes allowed in Part II, Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, which are not in conflict with Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law. The corporation shall not engage in any other activity not permitted by the regulations prescribed by an organization which is tax exempt under organization described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.

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ARTICLE IV

The manner in which the directors and officers of the corporation are elected or appointed shall be set forth in the By-Laws of the corporation. The members of this corporation shall consist of the persons hereinafter named as incorporators and such other persons as from time to time hereafter may become members in the manner provided by the By-Laws.

ARTICLE V

The term of existence of this corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE VI

The name and the street address of the initial registered agent is Richard F. Manilley, 3750 Lakemont Drive, Bonita Springs, Florida 33923.
