

Articles of Incorporation of the undersigned, who are citizens of the United States, desiring to form a Non-Profit Corporation under the Non-Profit Corporation law of the State of Florida, do hereby certify:

Article I

The name of the Corporation shall be Ojisan Foundation for the Arts Inc.

Article II

The principal place of business and mailing address of this corporation located in Leon County, City of Tallahassee, Florida, shall be:

Article III

The specific purposes for which the corporation is organized are to:

1. Develop and maintain a non-degree granting community school of the arts that will afford educational opportunities to community residents regardless of race, sex, creed or national origin.

2. Develop and maintain a supportive relationship with the art programs of Leon County public schools with a primary emphasis on programs designed to serve students identified by school officials as "at risk" as well as

those interested in the arts.

 Develop communication links with social service agencies and community programs serving students "at risk" throughout the surrounding community.

Article IV

The manner in which the directors are elected or appointed is contained in the by-laws of Ojisan Foundation for the Arts Inc.

Article V

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compenstion for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article Third No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be hereof. the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in, (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170 (c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

Article VI

The corporate powers of Ojisan Foundation for the Δrts are as provided in section 617.0302, Florida Statutes.

Article VII

Upon the dissolution of the Corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
