ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF 2-28-95

NATIONAL DUCT MASTIC MANUFACTURERS ASSOCIATION, INC.

A FLORIDA NON-PROFIT CORPORATION

The undersigned, acting as incorporator of a nonprofit Corporation pursuant to Chapter 617, Florida Statues, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation for such Corporation:

ARTICLE I NAME

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 The name of the Corporation is the NATIONAL DUCT MASTIC MANUFACTURERS ASSOCIATION, INC. Its principal office will be at 214 Royal Oak Circle, Longwood, Florida 32779-3543.

ARTICLE II
DURATION

The period of the duration of this Corporation is perpetual, unless dissolved according to law., In accordance with Section 617.014, Florida Statutes, the date when corporate existence shall commence is the date of subscription and acknowledgment of these Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE III PURPOSE

The purposes for which the Corporation is organized are:

- A. To serve as a trade or business association for the duct mastic manufacturing industry and related businesses, in the United States.
  - B. To hold meetings, seminars, workshops, and other gatherings to promote, sponsor, and improve the duct mastic manufacturing industry, and related businesses in the United States.
- C. To keep abreast of changes and new developments in the duct mastic manufacturing industry, and to educate and inform the membership of the corporation as to such changes and new developments.
- D. To solicit, receive, hold and disburse funds, and to acquire, hold, convey, rent and mortgage real and personal property, all to assist the corporation in furthering its objectives of promoting sponsoring and improving the duct mastic manufacturing industry in the United States.
  - E. To develop an informed and enlightened public understanding of the duct mastic manufacturing industry and the role that it serves.

- F. To support sound and responsible legislation that has an effect upon the duct mastic industry.
- G. To make contributions to any organizations described in Section 501(c)(6) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future U.S. Internal Revenue Law) which are organized for purposes similar to those of this organization.
- H. To operate exclusively always in any other manner as will gualify it as an exempt organization under Section 501 (c)(6) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as amended, or tax laws, covering exempt organizations under the Internal Revenue Code, including private foundations and private operating foundations.
  - I. To represent the common interests of duct mastic industry at hearings, meetings, and conferences held by legislative and other public administrative bodies on national, state and local levels.
  - J. To engage in any lawful act or activity for which corporations may be formed under the Florida Not for Profit Corporation Act.
- 20 K. To do such other things as are incidental to the purposes 21 of the Corporation or necessary or desirable in order to 22 accomplish them and otherwise to advance the common purposes of 23 its Members.
