# AMENDED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF YOUTHS LIVING IN A FREE ENVIRONMENT, 184

The undersigned, to form a nonprofit corporation under Florida Statutes Chapter 617, do hereby make and adopt the following in Articles of Incorporation:

#### ARTICLE ONE

(Name)

The name of the corporation is YOUTHS LIVING IN A FREE ENVIRONMENT, INC.

#### ARTICLE TWO

(Limitations)

This corporation shall engage exclusively in such educational, literary, or charitable activities as will qualify it for tax exempt status under section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 or corresponding provisions of any subsequent federal tax laws.

This corporation shall not be organized or operated for the pecuniary profit of its directors, officers, or members; nor may it issue stock or declare. No part of the net income or assets of this corporation shall insure to the benefit of any director, officer, or member thereof, or to the benefit of any private individual.

This corporation shall not, as a substantial part of its activities, carry out propaganda or otherwise attempt to influence legislation; nor it participates or intervenes in any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

### ARTICLE THREE (Purpose)

The purpose of this corporation shall be

- 1. To offer emergency assistance to those in need.
- 2. To create cultural and community event programs.
- Charitable and educational programs within the meaning of section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue.

- 4. Create youth and senior citizen programs.
- 5. Offer community and social services concerning Education, Food Distribution and Job Referrals.
- 6. To exercise all rights and powers conferred by the laws of the State of Florida upon nonprofit corporations, including without limiting the generality of the foregoing, to acquire by bequest, devise, gift, purchase, lease or otherwise any property of any sort or nature without limitation as to amount or value, and to disburse, lease, mortgage, convey, option, donate or otherwise dispose of such property and the income, principal and proceeds of such property, for any of the purposes set forth herein.
- 7. Offer child care programs.
- 8. Create programs to help individuals in need to adapt and cope in the community and in society.

#### ARTICLE FOUR

(Members)

Membership qualification and the procedures for admission to membership in this corporation's bylaws.

#### ARTICLE FIVE

(Bylaws)

The Bylaws of the Corporation are to be made and adopted by the Board of Directors, and may be altered, amended or rescinded by the Board of Director.
