ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF SPORTS EMBASSY FOUNDATION, INC.

{A NON-PROFIT CORPORATION}



The undersigned, acting as incorporator of a corporation pursuant to Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation of such corporation

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation shall be SPORTS EMBASSY FOUNDATION, INC.

The initial principal place of business of this corporation shall be: 21218 St. Andrews Boulevard #10-222, Boca Raton, Florida 33433.

ARTICI.E II

The period of the duration of this corporation is perpetual unless dissolved according to law.

ARTICLE III

The corporation is a non-profit charitable organization formed for the purpose of developing a community project to provide facilities, equipment and services for the physically challenged with a focus on education, medical, medical-related, nutrition, therapy and therapeutic sports-oriented entertainment activity. CERTIFICATE OF AMENDMENT OF THE ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF SPORTS EMBASSY FOUNDATION, INC.

SPORTS EMBASSY FOUNDATION, INC., a not-for-profit corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Florida,

DOES HEREBY CERTIFY:

FIRST, that at a meeting of the Board of Directors of Sports Embassy Foundation, Inc., resolutions were proposed setting forth an Amendment to the Articles of Incorporation of said corporation, declaring said Amendment to be advisable.

SECOND, that there are no members entitled to vote, the Board of Directors has the sole authority to vote on matters relating to the Company and its policies.

The Resolution setting forth the proposed Amendment is as follows:

RESOLVED, that notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, this organization shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1985 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Revenue law.

RESOLVED, that upon dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state of local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, a said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

THIRD, that thereafter, pursuant to the resolutions the Directors voted unanimously in favor of the Amendment to the Articles of Incorporation.
