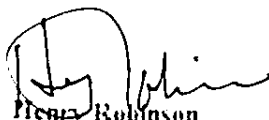

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
OVERTIME UNLIMITED DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION

FIRST: We the undersigned, Henry Robinson and Maxwell Robinson whose post office address is _____ Jacksonville, Florida, and R. C. Jenkins of 14122 Crystal Cove Drive, Jacksonville, Florida 32224 being at least twenty one years of age do hereby form a corporation under the general laws of the state of Florida.

SECOND: The name of the corporation is Overtime Unlimited Development Corporation

THIRD: The period of its duration is perpetual.

FOURTH: The purpose for which the corporation is organized is the transaction of any of all lawful business for which corporations may be incorporated under the Florida Corporation Act. The primary purposes are as follows:

- (1) to assist with promoting programs on anti-crime, drug prevention, job training, health education and structured recreational programs to primarily benefit low and moderate income families residing in and around the Northeast Florida region.
- (2) to develop programs to meet other community needs having a particular urgency because existing conditions pose a serious and immediate threat to the health or welfare of the community and
- (3) to provide programs to find special services where other financial resources are not available to meet such needs through self help programs; to expand the scope of programs and activities of public and private agencies, and institutions; to equalize minorities and disadvantaged individuals who heretofore have not received a fair opportunity to share in the riches of this country, the United States; to provide outreach and to encourage the active participation of minorities and disadvantaged communities in establishing self help projects and programs; to provide greater interaction and cooperation between organizations designed to assist minorities and hapless communities in the areas of crime prevention, recreation, physical planning, technical assistance to the elderly and dependent; to provide financial and technical assistance to the underserved population within the surrounding catchment area and actively participate in regionwide programs which seek to develop greater business and economic opportunities for minorities and the disadvantaged.

FOURTH: The principal office and address of Overtime Unlimited Development Corporation will be _____ Jacksonville, Florida 32208.

FIFTH The Corporation shall not be authorized to issue capital stock.

SIXTH. The number of directors for the Corporation shall be five, which number may be increased or decreased pursuant to the by-laws of the Corporation and the names of the directors who shall act until the first meeting or until their successors are duly chosen and qualified are Henry Robinson, President, Maxwell Robinson, Treasurer, Secretary and R. C. Jenkins, member.

SEVEN. The Board of Directors is empowered to make, alter or repeal the by-laws of the Corporation without restriction of their power conferred by statute.

EIGHT. In the event of dissolution of this corporation, or in the event it shall cease to carry out the objectives and purposes herein set forth, all business, property, and assets of the corporation or municipal corporations as may be selected by the board of directors of this corporation, to be used for and devoted to the purpose of carrying on a non-profit organization as prescribed or other purposes to promote the general social welfare of the community. In no event shall any of the assets or property, in the event of dissolution thereof, go or be distributed to members, either for the reimbursement of any sum subscribed, donated, or contributed by such members or for any other purposes, provided that nothing herein shall prohibit the corporation from paying its just debts.

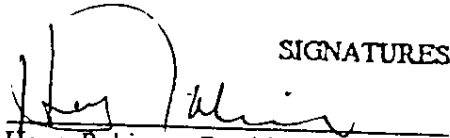

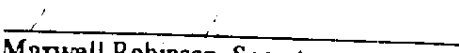

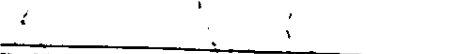
