ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

GREATER CLEARWATER TIMES TURKEY TROT TRACK TEAM BOOSTERS CLUB, INC.

The undersigned, acting as incorporator of a not for profit corporation pursuant to Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation is: GREATER CLEARWATER TIMES TURKEY TROT TRACK TEAM BOOSTERS CLUB, INC.

ARTICLE II

The street address of the initial principal office of the corporation shall be 2555 Enterprise Road, Clearwater, Florida, 34623, and the mailing address of the corporation shall be 2555 Enterprise Road, Clearwater, Florida, 34623.

ARTICLE_III

The purpose for which this not for profit corporation is organizer is to promote the Greater Clearwater Times Turkey Trot Track Team, to serve as a resource organization and fund raising organization for the track team and to support the members of the Greater Clearwater Times Turkey Trot Track Team including providing financial, emotional and Ancational support. corporation intends to fund local track meets, provide scholarships to those children wishing to participate in track but who are financially unable to pay the dues and tutoring for athletes maintaining a grade point average under 2.0. The Corporation proposes to fund travel expenses for the coach and qualified athletes achieving national and or international timing standards for track meets located across the United States. Notwithstanding any of the foregoing statements of purposes, this corporation shall only engage in activities or exercise powers which are permitted by an organization exempt from federal income tar under Section 501(c)(3) of the United States Internal Revenue Code.

ARTICLE_IV

The method of election of directors shall be as stated in the bylaws.

ARTICLE V

The corporate powers of this corporation are as provided in Section 617.0302, Florida Statutes.

- a. No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributed to its members, governors, officers or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article III hereof.
- b. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distributing of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.
- c. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by such an organization exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the United States Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
- c. Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the circuit court of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
