ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF

IOLA LAKESIDE VILLAGE ASSOCIATION, INC.

In compliance with the requirements of Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, the undersigned, all of whom are residents of the State of Florida, and all of whom are of full age, have this day voluntarily associated themselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation not for profit, and do hereby certify:

ARTICLE I
NAME

The name of the corporation is IOLA LAKESIDE VILLAGE ASSOCIATION, INC.

ARTICLE II
ADDRESS

The principal office of the Association is located at 35310 Highway 54 West, Zephyrhills, Florida, 33541.

ARTICLE III
REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT

The street address of the initial registered office of the Association shall be 37837 Meridian Avenue, Suite 314, Dade City,

Florida, 33525. The name of the Association's initial registered agent at such address shall be LEONARD H. JOHNSON.

ARTICLE IV
PURPOSE AND POWERS OF THE ASSOCIATION

This Association does not contemplate pecuniary gain or profit of its members. The specific purposes for which it is formed are to promote the health, safety, and general welfare of the residents within the property described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof by reference, herein called the "Properties". The purposes of this Association shall include, without limitation of the foregoing, the maintenance of the Common Area and certain other land within the Properties, and carrying out, enforcing and otherwise fulfilling its rights and responsibilities under and pursuant to that certain Declaration of Covenants and Restrictions for IOLA LAKESIDE VILLAGE, to be recorded among the Public Records of Pasco County, Florida, and any amendments or modifications

thereof, herein together called the "Declaration". The Association is empowered to:

(a) Exercise all of the powers and privileges and to perform all of the duties and obligations of the Association as set forth in that certain Declaration of Covenants and Restrictions, hereinafter called the "Declaration", applicable to the property and recorded or to be recorded in the Public Records of Pasco, Florida, and as the same may be amended from time to time as therein provided, said Declaration being incorporated herein as if set forth at length;

(b) Fix, levy, collect and enforce payment by any lawful means, all charges or assessments pursuant to the terms of the Declaration; to pay all expenses in connection therewith and all office and other expenses incident to the conduct of the business of the Association, including all licenses, taxes or governmental charges levied or imposed against the property of the Association;

(c) Acquire (by gift, purchase or otherwise), own, hold, improve, build upon, operate, maintain, convey, sell, lease, transfer, dedicate for public use or otherwise dispose of real or personal property in connection with the affairs of the Association;

(d) Borrow money, and with the assent of two-thirds (2/3) of each class of members, mortgage, pledge, deed in trust, or hypothecate any or all of its real or personal property as security for money borrowed or debts incurred;

(e) Dedicate, sell or transfer all or any part of the Common Area, including roadways, to any public agency, authority, or utility. No such dedication or transfer shall be effective unless an instrument has been signed by a majority of the Board of Directors agreeing to such dedication, sale or transfer;

(f) Grant easements as to the Common Area to public and private utility companies, including cable T.V., and to public bodies or governmental agencies or other entities or persons, with or without cost or charge, at the sole discretion of the Board of Directors, where convenient, desirable or necessary in connection with the development of the Properties, and the providing of utility and other services thereto;

(g) Participate in mergers and consolidations with other non-profit corporations organized for the same purposes, or annex additional residential property and Common Area, provided that any such merger, consolidation or annexation shall have the assent of two-thirds (2/3) of each class of members;

(h) Annex additional real property in accordance with the provisions of the Declaration, with such annexations, when completed in accordance with the provisions of the Declaration, extending the jurisdiction, function, duties and membership of the Association to the real property thereby annexed;

(i) From time to time adopt, alter, amend and rescind reasonable rules and regulations governing the use of the Common Area, which rules and regulations shall be consistent with the rights and duties established by the Declaration and with the provisions of these Articles of Incorporation;

(j) Contract for the maintenance and management of the Common Area, and to authorize a management agent to assist the Association in carrying out its powers and duties under the Declaration;

(k) Have and exercise any and all powers, rights and privileges which a corporation organized under the Non-Profit Corporation Law of the State of Florida by law as it may now or hereafter have or exercise; and

(l) This Association is not a condominium association and is not subject to the Florida Condominium Law (F.S. 718).

ARTICLE V
MEMBERSHIP

Every person or entity who is a record Owner of a fee or undivided fee interest in any Lot which is subject to the provisions of the Declaration, including contract sellers, shall be a member of the Association. When any Lot is owned of record by two (2) or more persons or other legal entities, all such persons or entities shall be members. An Owner of more than one (1) such Lot shall be entitled to one (1) membership for each Lot owned by him. Membership shall be appurtenant to, and may not be separated from, ownership of any Lot which is subject to the provisions of the Declaration, but shall be automatically transferred by the conveyance of that Lot.

ARTICLE VI
VOTING RIGHTS

The Association shall have one (1) class of voting membership. All votes shall be cast in the manner provided in the Bylaws. When more than one person or entity holds an interest in any Lot, the vote for such Lot shall be exercised as such persons determine, but in no event shall more than the number of votes hereinafter designated be cast with respect to any such Lot, nor shall any

split vote be permitted with respect to such Lot. The class of voting memberships and voting rights related thereto is as follows:

(a) Class A. Class A members shall be all owners of Lots subject to assessment. Owners of Class A Lots shall be entitled to one (1) vote for each Lot owned.

ARTICLE VII

BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The affairs of this Association shall be managed by a Board of not less than three (3) nor more than five (5) Directors, who need not be members of the Association. The number of directors may be changed by amendment of the Bylaws of the Association. The names and addresses of the persons who are to act in the capacity of directors until the selection of their successors are:

BYLAWS

The first Bylaws of the Association shall be adopted by the Board of Directors, and may be altered, amended or rescinded in the manner provided by the Bylaws.

ARTICLE X
INDEMNIFICATION

Every Director and every Officer of the Association shall be indemnified by the Association against all expenses and liabilities, including counsel fees, reasonably incurred by or imposed upon him in connection with any proceeding or any settlement of any proceeding to which he may be a party or to which he may become involved by reason of his being or having been a Director or Officer of the Association, whether or not he is a Director or Officer at the time such expenses are incurred. The foregoing right of indemnification shall be in addition to and not exclusive of all other rights to which such Director or Officer may be entitled.

ARTICLE XI
DISSOLUTION

The Association may be dissolved with the assent given in writing and signed by not less than two-thirds (2/3) of the members. Upon dissolution of the Association, other than incident to a merger or consolidation, the assets of the Association shall be dedicated to an appropriate public agency to be used for purposes similar to those for which this Association was created. In the event that such dedication is refused acceptance, such

assets shall be granted, conveyed and assigned to any non-profit corporation, association, trust or other organization to be devoted to such similar purpose.

ARTICLE XI.
DURATION

The Corporation shall exist perpetually.

ARTICLE XIII
AMENDMENTS

Amendment of these Articles shall require the assent of two-thirds (2/3) of the total votes cast of each class at any regular or special meeting of the membership duly called and conveyed.
