AMENDMENTS TO ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION COMMUNITY COALITION ON HOMELESSNESS CORPORATION

TO EACH OF THE NOTED ARTICLES ADD THE FOLLOWING:

ARTICLE III

The purposes for which the Corporation is organized are exclusively religious, charitable, scientific, literary and educational within the meaning of section 501© (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Revenue Law.

ARTICLE V

Notwithstanding any other provisions of these articles, this organization shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal income tax under section 501 © (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corread ading section of any future United States Internal Revenue law.

ARTICLE V

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501 © (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of competent jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
