ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF A CORPORATION FOR NON PROFIT PERUVIAN TRADITIONS FESTIVAL, INC.

In order to form a corporation under and in accordance with the provisions of the laws of the State of Florida for the formation of corporations not for profit, we the undersigned, hereby associate ourselves into a corporation for the purpose and with the powers hereinafter mentioned; and to that end we do, by these Articles of Incorporation, set for:

ARTICLE I: NAME

The name of this corporation is: PERUVIAN TRADITIONS FESTIVAL, INC.

ARTICLE II : LOCATION

The street address, city, county and state in which the principal offices are to be located at 4805 N.W. 79th AVE., Miami, Florida 33166. The Board of Directors may from time to time designated such other address and place for the principal office of this corporation as it may see

ARTICLE III: DURATION

This corporation shall have perpetual existence commencing on the date of the filling of this Articles with the Department of State.

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ARTICLE IV : PURPOSES

Those corporation shall issued no stock.

No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall be the carrying of the propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation.

This corporation shall not participate or intervene in any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office, including the publishing or distribution of statements.

No withstanding any other activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501 (e) (3) of the Internal Revenue Service Code of 1954 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Service Law.

ARTICLE V : POWERS

The corporation shall have the following powers:

- The corporation shall have all the powers and privileges granted to corporations not
 profit under the law pursuant to which this corporation is chartered.
- 2.- The corporation shall have all the powers reasonably necessary to implement and affectuate the purposes of this corporation, including but not limited to the following:

Any assets not so disposed of, shall be disposed of by court of competence jurisdiction in the county where the principal office of this corporation in then located.
