ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION FOR BETHEL CHURCH

BETHEL CHURCH
OF JESUS CHRIST
(APOSTOLIC), INC.

The undersigned hereby declares that the purpose of becoming a corporation not for profit under Chapter 617, Laws of the State of Plorida, providing for the formation, liability, rights, privileges and immunities of a corporation not for profit.

ARTICLE T. CORPORATE NAME

The name of this corporation is: BETHEL CHURCH OF JESUS CHRIST (APOSTOLIC), INC.

ARTICLE II. NATURE OF BUSINESS AND POWERS

The general nature of the business to be transacted by this corporation is to engage in:

(A) To preach the Gospel, to administer the ordinances of the New Testament, to minister to the spiritual needs of its members and all people everywhere, to train Christian workers for the Lord's work, and to further the evangelization of the world by helping men, women and children know Christ as their personal Lord and Savior.

STATEMENTS OF FAITH (Unalterable Provisions)

- (1) THE WORD OF GOD We believe that the Bible is the Word of God, fully inspired and without error in the original manuscripts, written under the inspiration of the Holy Spirit, and that it has supreme authority in all matters of faith and conduct, (Jn.17:17;Rom.15:4;2 Tim. 3:16, 17: 2 Pet. 1:19-21).
- (2) THE TRINITY We believe that there is one living and true God, eternally existing in three persons; that these are equal in every divine perfection, and that they execute distinct but harmonious offices in the work of the creation providence and redemption. (Matt. 28:19; Jn. 1:1-4; Jn. 5:7).
- (3) GOD THE PATHER We believe in God, the father, an infinite personal spirit, perfect in holiness, wisdom, power and love. We believe that He concerns Himself mercifully in the affairs of men, that He hears and answers prayers, that He saves from sin and death all who come to Him through Jesus Christ. (Jn. 3:16 17; Jn. 4:24; Jn. 17:5).
- (4) JESUS CHRIST We believe in Jesus Christ, God's only begotten Son, conceived by the Holy Spirit. We believe in his virgin birth, sinless life, miracles and teachings. We believe in His substitutionary atoning death, bodily resurrection, ascension into heaven, perpetual intercession for His people, and personal visible return to earth. (Isa. 7:14; Jn. 1:14; Phil. 2:5-11; Heb. 1:2.3; Jn. 1:7; 1 Jn. 5:18).

- (5) THE HOLY SPIRIT We believe in the Holy Spirit who came troth from the Father and Son to convince the world of ain, righteousness, and judgment, and to regenerate, sanctify, and empower all who believe in Jeans Christ. We believe that the Holy Spirit indwells every believer in Christ, and that He is an abiding helper, teacher and guide. (Jn. 14:26; Jn. 16:7-15; Rom. 8: 14-17; Eph. 1:13-14),
- (6) REGENERATION We believe that all men are sinners in nature and choice are, therefore, under condemnation. We believe that those who repent of their sins and trust in Jesus Christ as Savior are regenerated by the Holy Spirit. (Ju. 1:12, 13:Jn. 3:3, 16, 17: Ac. 20:21: Eph. 2:1-9: Tit. 3:5).
- (7) THE CHURCH We believe in the universal church, a living apiritual body of which Christ is the Head and regenerated persons are members. We believe in the local church, consisting of a company of believers in Jesus Christ baptized on a credible profession of faith, and associated for worship, work and fellowship. We believe that God has laid upon the members of the local church the primary task of giving the Gospel of Jesus Christ to a lost world. (Mark 16:15, 16; Ac. 2:38-41; Eph. 2 19-22; Eph. 5:25-27).
- (8) CHRISTIAN CONDUCT We believe that a Christian should live for the glory of God and the well being of his fellowmen; that his conduct should be blameless before the world; that he should be a faithful steward of his possessions and that he should seek to realize for himself and others, to the full stature of maturity in Christ. (2 Cor. 9:6-8:Eph. 4:11-16; Phil. 2:14-16; Col. 3: 17-23; 1 Thess. 5:17-18).
- (9) THE ORDINANCES We believe that the Lord Jesus Christ has committed two ordinances to the local church, baptism and the Lord's Supper. We believe that the Christian baptism is the immersion of a believer in water in the name of the triune God. We believe that the Lord's Supper was instituted by Christ Jesus for commemoration of His death. We believe that these two ordinances should be observed and administered until the return of the Lord Jesus Christ. (Matt. 28: 18-20; Ac. 2:41-41; Rom. 6:3-5; 1 Cor. 11:23-32).
- (10) RELIGIOUS LIBERTY We believe that every human being has direct relations with God, and is responsible to God alone in all matters of faith; that each church is independent and must be free from interference by any ecclesiastical or political authority; that therefore church and state must be kept separate as having different functions each fulfilling its duties free from dictation or patronage of the other.
- (11) CHURCH COOPERATION We believe that local churches can best promote the cause of Jesus Christ by cooperating with one another in a denominational organization. Such an organization, whether regional or district conference, exists and functions by the will of the churches. Cooperation with interdenominational fellowships on a voluntary independent basis.
- (12) LAST THINGS We believe in the personal and visible return of the Lord Jesus Christ to earth and the establishment of His kingdom. We believe in the resurrection of the body, the final judgme., the eternal happiness of the righteous, and the endless suffering of the wicked. (jn. 5:28, 29; Rev. 20:1-15; 2 Cor. 5:10; Matt. 25: 31-46).

(B) To take, necure, accept, hold or acquire, by gift, purchase, legacy or otherwise, real and personal property, when it may deem the same proper, necessary and expedient in the work and purposes for which this body was organized and incorporated; and to hold lease, incumber, give, exchange or sell and transfer and dispose of the same, in part and in whole, when it deems such action expedient, necessary or beneficial in promoting and advancing the work and purposes for which this corporation was formed; and shall have all the powers and duties set forth under Florida and Federal laws regarding not, for profit corporations, except where variances permitted by law appear in these Articles.

ARTICLE III. TERM OF EXISTENCE

This corporation shall have perpetual existence, commencing upon the filing of these articles with the Secretary of State for the State of Florida.

ARTICLE IV. INITIAL REGISTERED AGENT AND INITIAL REGISTERED OFFICE

ARTICLE V. MEMBERSHIP

The government of this church is vested in the body of members who compose it. Thus the final authority for decision shall be the congregation to whom the Church Boa. I and staff are responsible. Membership in the Corporation shall be duly determined in accordance with the Church Bylaws, such Bylaws shall be approved by the Board of Trustees and Membership at a duly called meeting for that purpose.

ARTICLE VI. BOARD OF TRUSTEES

This corporation shall have three trustees initially. The number of trustees may be increased or diminished from time to time by Bylaws adopted by the members and board of trustees, but shall never be less than three. The Bylaws shall determine those persons elected as Trustees. The Trustees shall be elected from the membership during the Annual business meeting.

ARTICLE XI. ORGANIZATION OF CHURCH

This corporation is organized under a non-stock basis.

ARTICLE XII. TAX EXEMPT STATUS

No part of the income or losses of this corporation shall be distributed to its members and/or trustees, except as compensation for actual services rendered. In the event of dissolution, the residual assets of the organization will be turned over to one or more organizations which themselves are exempt as organizations described in Section 501 (c)(3) and 170 (c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 or corresponding sections of any prior or future law, or the Federal, State, or Local Government for exclusive public purpose.

ARTICLE XIII. INDEMNIFICATION OF TRUSTEES AND OFFICERS

All officers and trustees shall be indemnified by the Church/Corporation against all expenses and liabilities including attorney's fees (including appellate proceedings) reasonably incurred in connection with any proceeding or settlement thereof is which they may become involved by reason of holding such office. The Church may purchase and maintain insurance on behalf of all officers and trustees against any liability asserted against them in their capacity as officers and trustees or arising out of their status as such.

ARTICLE XIV. BYLAWS

The Bylaws of the Church shall be adopted by the Board of Trusteen and may be altered, amended or rescinded in the manner provided in the Bylaws.
