## ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION FOR

The undersigned, acting as the incorporator for the purpose of forming a not-for-profit corporation pursuant to Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

Article I

EFFECTIVE DATE

NAME

The name of the Corporation shall be THE CHILDRENS' & SURVIVORS' FUND, INC.

## Article II

## PRINCIPAL OFFICE AND MAILING ADDRESS

The principal office and current mailing address of the Corporation is as follows:

## Article III

## **PURPOSE**

The purposes for which the Corporation is organized are as follows:

A. To receive and administer funds and to operate exclusively for purposes permitted under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended from time to time, or comparable provisions of subsequent legislation (the "Code"). Among these purposes are selling merchandize substantially all of which has been donated to the Corporation as gifts or contributions and distributing any net profits from such sales to one or more organizations selected by the Board of Trustees of the Corporation, provided that such organizations are exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Code or directly donating such merchandize to such exempt organizations. Among the organizations that shall be eligible for such funds shall be substance abuse centers or other organizations that benefit or promote the health, welfare and social and educational needs of children and young adults challenged by comparably formidable circumstances.

- B. To acquire, own, purchase, lease, dispose of and deal with real and personal property and interests, either absolutely or in trust therein and to apply gifts, grants, bequests, and devises and the proceeds thereof in furtherance of the purposes of the Corporation as set out in these Articles of Incorporation.
- C. To do such things and to perform such acts to accomplish the purposes set out in these Articles of Incorporation as the Board of Trustees may determine to be appropriate and as are not forbidden by these Articles of Incorporation.

## Article IV

## TERH

Corporate existence shall commence upon the date of execution of these Articles of Incorporation and the term of Corporation shall be perpetual.

## Article V

#### POWERS

The Corporation shall have all of the common law and statutory powers of a corporation not for profit pursuant to the laws of the State of Florida that are not in conflict with the terms of these Articles of Incorporation, provided, however, that notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles of Incorporation, such powers may be utilized only for the purposes set out in these Articles of Incorporation and, provided further, that the Corporation shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from federal income tax pursuant to Section 501(c)(3) of the Code.

## Article VI

## LIMITATIONS

The Corporation shall be operated as a nonprofit corporation exclusively for the purposes set out in these Articles of Incorporation. No individual trustee, officer or director of the Corporation shall have any title to or interest in the corporate property or earnings in his or her individual or private capacity and no part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of any director, trustee, officer, member or any private individual, other than as reasonable compensation for

services actually rendered. No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, nor shall the Corporation participate in or intervene in any political campaign on behalf of (or in opposition to) any candidate for public office. The Corporation shall not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national or ethnic origin as such terms are defined for purposes of qualifying under Section 501(c)(3) of the Code.

### Articlo VII

#### MEMBERS

There shall be no members of the Corporation.

## Article VIII

## TRUSTEES

- (a) <u>Powers.</u> All corporate powers shall be exercised by or under the authority of, and the affairs of the Corporation shall be managed under the direction of, the Board of Trustees.
- (b) <u>Number</u>. The number of trustees shall be determined from time to time in accordance with the By-Laws, but shall never be less than three trustees, and, in the absence of any such determination, shall be at least three trustees.
- (c) <u>Election; removal.</u> Trustees shall be elected or removed in accordance with the procedures provided in the By-Laws.

## Article IX

If the Corporation is ever dissolved, the residual assets of the Corporation shall be turned over to one or more organizations selected by the Board of Trustees of the Corporation, provided such

organizations are exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Code and benefit or promote the health, welfare and social and educational needs of children.
