AMENDMENT

ARTICLE XI  
BYLAWS

PURPOSES

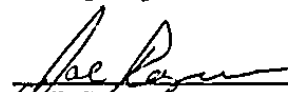
The purpose for which the corporation is organized is to teach and develop skills and fundamentals of football and to promote sportsmanship and teamwork.
