

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 617.1006 of the Florida Not For Profit Corporation Act, the undersigned, Florida Partnership of the Americas, Inc., a Florida non-profit corporation, does hereby make and execute these Articles of Amendment to its Articles of Incorporation:

1. The name of the corporation is Florida Partnership of the Americas, Inc.

2. The Articles of Incorporation are amended as follows:

ARTICLE IV

BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The Corporation shall be organized on a non-stock basis. The authority for all affairs of the Corporation shall be in a Board of Directors who shall have and may exercise all the powers of the Corporation as permitted by federal law, state law, these Articles of Incorporation and the Bylaws of the Corporation as from time to time in effect. The Corporation shall have such number of members of the Board of Directors as shall be set forth in the Bylaws of the Corporation in effect from time to time, and the Board of Directors shall be elected in the manner set forth in the Bylaws.

3. Members are not entitled to vote. This amendment was adopted by the board of directors on May 28, 1998.
