A Non-Profit Corporation

We, the undersigned, all being sui jures, do hereby agree for ourselves, under the laws of the State of Florida, and pursuant to Florida Statues Sections 617.0202 et seq... and the provisions, therein providing for the formation, rights, privileges benefits, obligations and liabilities conferred imposed by said laws on corporation not for profit, do hereby subscribe to and adopt the Articles of Incorporation set forth herein:

ARTICLE I: NAME

The name of the corporation shall be Life Skills For Juveniles, Incorporated.

ARTICLE II: PR'NCIPAL OFFICE

The principal office of Life Skills for Juveniles, Incorporated, shall be located at 1150 Lane Avenue South, south in the City of Jacksonville, Duval County, Florida, the mailing address of the corporation shall be the same.

ARTICLE III: PURPOSES

1) Life Skills for Juveniles, Incorporated, is organized for the expressed purpose of identifying, receiving and accepting male adolescents between the ages of thirteen and seventeen years; who have been considered by the court system to be offenders and refereed by the courts to Life Skills for Juveniles, Incorporated for program participation, and youths in the community who have not been subjected and exposed to the court systems, but who manifest high propensity and incorrigible conduct suggestive of potential family and community offensive behavior,

and resultant problems for the juvenile, parent(s) and community might be aborted.

- 2) The corporation has, and will utilize, a curriculum developed by professionals trained personnel in the areas of human growth and development and the problems adolescent encounter throughout the periods of growth, maturation and development, and the corporation and its program is designed, and will function to through the provision of meaningful life experiences and active individuals and group participation designed and such as to meet these needs of adolescent which are ignored due to the lack of any program targeting of the needs of juvenile offenders and potential juvenile offenders.
- 3) Pursuant to achieve of the goals of Life Skills for Juveniles, the youths will be exposed to experience structure to:
 - a) Enhance their academic skills
 - b) Enhance their interpersonal skills
 - c) Establish team building problem solving
 - d) Develop a peer network
 - c) Develop positive image
 - f) Introduction to employability skills
 - A) The nature of the activities in which the youths are required to participate in are:
 - 1) Study hall confinement for fulfillment homework assignments
 - 2) Intensive tutoring
 - 3) Computer workshops

- B. Personnel participants will include but not limited, volunteered professionals, trained teachers, tutors monitors, counselors, recreational therapist, and the evaluation process required pre- and post testing throughout the training program.

Participants youth will be picked up at there enrolled schools throughout the city and transported to the center daily, not later than 5:00 PM at which time classes will terminate at 9:00 PM and enrollees will be transported home thereafter; being under the supervisions of Life Skill for Juveniles, Incorporated.



Pursuant to the provisions of Section 617.1006 of the Florida Statutes, the understand corporation adopts the following Articles of Amendment to its Articles of Incorporation, pursuant to a consent meeting of all of the members of the Board of Directors and the members held August 23, 1995;

Article III of the Articles of Amendment shall be amended to add the following language as Section 4) of Article III:

"The purposes for which the Life Skills for Juveniles, Incorporated is organized are exclusively religious, charitable, scientific, literary and educational within the meaning of Section 501(e)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding pravision of any future United States Internal Revenue barr."

Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles of Incorporation, this organization shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law,"

2. The Articles of Incorporation are amended to add the following language as Article IV: Dissolution:

"ARTICLE IX: DISSOLUTION

Upon the dissolution of the Corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas of the county in which the principal office of the Corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations as said Court shall determine, which are organized or operated exclusively for such purposes."

In all other respects, except as specifically changed and modified in these Articles of Amendment to the Articles of Incorporation, all of the provisions contained in the Articles of Incorporation of Life Skills for Juveniles, Incorporated shall be and remain the same.
