

## ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF The Deltona Hispanic Sport Club, Inc.

We, the undersigned incorporators, hereby associate ourselves an make, subscribe, acknowledge and file with the Secretary of State of Florida these Articles of Incorporation for the purpose of forming a Corporation Not For Profit pursuant to Chapter 617 of the Florida Chapter.

### ARTICLE I

The name of this corporation shall be: The Deltona Hispanic Sport Club, Inc.

#### ARTICLE II PURPOSE

- A) This corporation is organized and shall be operated exclusively as a non- profit organization which uses the goals and methods of:

#### ARTICLE V TERMS OF EXISTENCE

This corporation shall have perpetual existence.

#### ARTICLE VII LOCATION OF PRINCIPLE OFFICES

The principle offices of this corporation shall be located in the Deltona Community in the State of Florida.

### ARTICLE VIII OFFICERS AND DIRECTORS
