Dear Ms. Turley:

Thank you for your assistance in helping us understand the necessary procedures for getting Escambia County Farm Bureau registered with the Florida Division of Corporations. As you are aware, when these county Farm Bureaus were formed in the 1940's and early 1950's the statutes governing Limited Agricultural Associations allowed them to be chartered with the clerk of their local Circuit Court. Through the years, we have had the assistance of your office in getting the Florida county Farm Bureaus registration transferred to Tallahassee; however, it appears that Escambia slipped through the cracks somehow, and has never been transferred. Based on what you have told us, and my understanding of 604.11, we are sending you the certificate of designation of registered agent, signed by the president of Escambia County Farm Bureau, a certified copy of the Articles of Incorporation, certified on December 15, 1954, plus an additional copy, as required under 604.11, and including a statement by R.A. Gray, the then Secretary of State for the State of Florida to the effect that there is no other Limited Agricultural Association of the same name as that used in the foregoing Articles of Association.

Also enclosed is a check, which includes \$5.25 registration outlined in 604, and the \$35.00 necessary to record a registered agent.

I hope this is all that you need to have Escambia County Farm Bureau properly registered under the State of Florida laws, as an active Association. Please contact me if you have questions, or need additional information. My direct line telephone number is (904) 374-1586.

ARTICLES OF ASSOCIATION OF  
ESCAMBIA COUNTY FARM BUREAU, LAA

ARTICLE I

The name of this Association shall be ESCAMBIA County Farm Bureau LAA, a limited agricultural Association.

ARTICLE II

The principal place of business of the Association shall be at MOLINO Florida.

ARTICLE III

The Association is formed for the following purposes:

Section 1. To promote, foster and encourage more efficient and progressive agriculture.

Section 2. To enable the farmers and growers of Florida to enjoy the manifold benefits of joint and collective effort.

Section 3. To work for the solution of the problems of the farm, the farm home, and rural community, by the use of the recognized advantages or organized action, to the end that those engaged in the various branches of agriculture may have opportunity for happiness and prosperity in their chosen work.

Section 4. To represent, protect and advance the social, economic and educational interests of farmers in Florida.

Section 5. To cooperate with Florida Farm Bureau Federation and through it, with the American Farm Bureau Federation, and with the Agricultural Extension Service in bringing their resources to the farmers of Florida.

Section 6. To do and perform any and all acts and things necessary, proper, convenient or desirable for and to effect the full and complete exercise and enjoyment of any and all of the powers and purposes of the Association hereby created.

This Association does not contemplate pecuniary gain to the members thereof.

ARTICLE IV

The Association shall have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE V

Section 1. The affairs and business of the association shall be managed by a managing committee to be known as the Board of Directors, of not less than three (3) members, who shall be members of the Association. The term of office of the directors shall be 1 years from and after their election, and/or until their successors are elected and qualified.

Section 2. The By-Laws shall provide for the election of a President, Vice-President, Secretary and Treasurer and shall prescribe their terms of office, time, place and manner of election, their powers and duties. Officers shall be members of the Association.

Section 3. The officers who are to conduct the business of the Association until their successors are elected and qualified are as follows:
