ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
FLORIDA STATE PRIMITIVE BAPTIST CHURCH CAMP, INC.
(FLORIDA NON-PROFIT CORPORATION)

ARTICLE I
CORPORATE NAME, PRINCIPAL OFFICE AND MAILING ADDRESS

The name of this corporation shall be FLORIDA STATE PRIMITIVE BAPTIST CHURCH CAMP, INC., a not for profit corporation.

ARTICLE II
CORPORATE NATURE

This is a nonprofit corporation, organized solely for general religious purposes pursuant to the Florida Corporations Not for Profit Law set forth in Section 617 of the Florida Statutes.

ARTICLE III
DURATION

The term of existence of the corporation is perpetual.

ARTICLE IV
GENERAL AND SPECIFIC PURPOSES

The specific and primary purposes for which this corporation is formed are:

A. Primary Purpose. For the advancement of Christian education, social ministries, recreational ministries and any other related or corresponding charitable purposes by the distribution of its funds for such purposes.

B. Specific Purpose. To operate exclusively in any other manner for such religious, charitable and educational purposes as will qualify it as an exempt organization under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as amended, or under any corresponding provisions of any subsequent federal tax laws, covering the distributions to organizations qualified as tax exempt organizations under the Internal Revenue Code, as amended, including private foundations and private operating foundations.

ARTICLE V
MANAGEMENT OF CORPORATE AFFAIRS

A. Camp Commission. The powers of this corporation shall be exercised, its properties controlled, and its affairs conducted by the Camp Commission consisting of not less than three (3) persons. The manner of election of the directors shall be as provided in the bylaws.

B. Initial Camp Commission. The Initial Camp Commission named herein shall hold office until such time as new members shall be elected thereto.

C. Election of Members. Members of the Commission shall be elected in accordance with rules, policies and procedures promulgated by the Florida State Primitive Baptist Convention and in the manner prescribed in its bylaws.

B. Corporate Officers. The Camp Commission shall elect the following officers: Vice Chair, Secretary, Assistant Secretary and Treasurer, and such other officers as the By-Laws of this corporation may authorize the Commission to elect from time to time. Initially, such officers shall be elected at the first annual meeting of the Camp Commission. The Chairman will be appointed by the Florida State Primitive Baptist Convention and confirmed by the convention body. Until such election is held, the following persons shall serve as corporate officers:

ARTICLE VI
EARNINGS AND ACTIVITIES OF CORPORATION

A. Net Earnings. No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its officers or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article IV hereof.

B. Political Action. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

C. Permitted Activities. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the United States Internal Revenue Law) or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

D. Exercise of Powers. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, this corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the purposes of this corporation.

ARTICLE VII
DISTRIBUTION OF ASSETS

Upon dissolution of the corporation, the Camp Commission shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all the liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all of the assets of the corporation exclusively for the organizations organized and operated exclusively for the purposes of the corporation in such manner, or to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, education, religious, or scientific purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law), as the Camp Commission shall determine. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a court of competent jurisdiction in the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations as such court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

ARTICLE VIII
MEMBERSHIP

The qualification for members and the manner of their admission shall be regulated by the rules, policies and procedures of the Florida State Primitive Baptist Convention.

Subject to the limitations contained in the bylaws, and any limitations set forth in the Corporations Not for Profit Law of the State of Florida, concerning corporate action that must be authorized or approved by the members of the corporation, by-laws of this corporation may be made, altered, rescinded, added to, or new bylaws of this corporation may be adopted, by following the procedures which may from time to time be promulgated by the Florida State Primitive Baptist Convention.

ARTICLE XI
DEDICATION OF ASSETS

This property of this corporation is irrevocably dedicated to religious, educational, and charitable purposes and no part of the net income or assets of this corporation shall ever inure to the benefit of any member of the Commission, officer or member thereof, or to the benefit of any private individual.

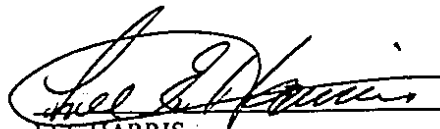
