ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT TO ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF THE FOUNDATION FOR SOCIAL JUSTICE, INC.

(a corporation not for profit)



1. The Articles of Incorporation of THE FOUNDATION FOR SOCIAL JUSTICE, INC. are hereby amended to insert a new ARTICLE X, to read as follows:

"ARTICLE X

The corporation, during any period when it is a "private foundation" under Internal Revenue Code Section 509(a), (1) shall distribute its income for each tax year at a time and in a manner as not to become subject to the tax on undistributed income imposed by Internal Revenue Code Section 4942 or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, (2) shall not engage in any act of self-dealing as defined in Internal Revenue Code Section 4941(d) or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, (3) shall not retain any excess business holdings as defined in Internal Revenue Code Section 4943(c), or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, (4) shall not make any investments in a manner as to subject it to tax under Internal Revenue Code Section 4944, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, and (5) shall not make any taxable expenditures as defined in Internal Revenue Code Section 4945(d) or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code."

2. The foregoing amendment was adopted by the approval of the Board of Directors and all of the Members of this Corporation on December 6, 2002. All Directors and Members unanimously voted in favor of the foregoing amendment and the number of votes cast for this amendment by each was sufficient for approval by such persons."
