AUTICIA IV

DRYINITIONS

The terms used in these ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION and the Dy-Laws shall have the meanings of those set forth in the Declaration of Condominium of COMQUISTADOR VILLAS COMPONINTUM and in the Florida Condominium Act, unless otherwise provided to the contrary, or unless the context otherwise requires.

ARTICUS Y

POWERS AND DUTTES

The Association does not contemplate pecuniary gain or profit to the members thereof, and the specific purpose for which it is formed is to provide for maintenance, preservation and exchitectural control of the units and Common Elements within that certain tract of property described above in Article III, and to promote for the health, safety and welfare of the residents within the above-described property and any additions thereto as may hereafter be brought within the jurisdiction of this Association for this purpose to:

- (a) exercise all of the powers and privileges and to perform all of the duties and obligations of the Association as set forth in that cortain Declaration of Covenants, Conditions and Restrictions, heroinefter called the "Declaration", applicable to the property and recorded or to be recorded in the Division of Florida Land and Bales Condominium and Clerk of the Courts in Dade County, Florida, and as the same may be amended from time to time as therein provided, said Declaration being incorporated herein as if fully set forth;
- (b) fix, levy, collect and enforce payment by any lawful means, all charges or assessments pursuant to the terms of this Declaration; to pay all expenses in connection therewith and all office and other expenses incident to the conduct of the business of the Association, including all licenses, taxes or governmental charges levied or imposed against the property of the Association;
- (c) acquire (by gift, purchase or otherwise), own, hold improve, build upon, operate, maintain, convey, sell, lease, transfer, dedicate for public use or otherwise dispose of real property in connection with the affairs of the Association.
- (d) borrow money, and with the assent of two-thirds (2/3rds) of the members, mortgage, pledge, deed in trust, or hypothecate any or all of its real or personal property as security for money borrowed or debts incurred;

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- (e) dodicate, sell or transfer all or any part of the Common Blaments to any public agency, authority, or utility for such purposes and subject to such conditions as may be agreed to by the members. No such dedication or transfer shall be effective unloss an instrument has been signed by two-thirds (2/3rds) of the members, agreeing to such dedication, sale or transfer;
- (f) participate in morgos and consolidations with other non-profit corporations organised for the same purpose or annox additional residential property and Common Elements, provided that any such marger, consolidation or annexation shall have the assent of two-thirds (2/3rds) of the members;
- (g) have and to exercise any and all powers, rights and privileges which a corporation organized under the Non-Profit Corporation Law of the State of Florida, by law may now or hereafter have or exercise.

ARTICLE VI

MEMBERSHILP

Every person or entity who is a record owner in the Public Records of Dada County, Florida of a fee or undivided fee interest of any unit, which is subject to the covenants of record to assessment by the Association, shall be a member of the Association. The foregoing is not intended to include persons or entities who hold an interest morely as security for the performance of an obligation. Membership shall be appurtenant to and may not be separated from ownership of any unit which is subject to assessment by the Association. Such membership shall automatically terminate when such person is no longer the record owner of a condominium unit.

Subject to the foregoing, admission to and termination of membership, shall be governed by the Doclaration of Condominium that is filed for said condominium among the public records of Dade County, Florida.

VOTING RIGHTS

Members of the association shall be entitled to one (I) vote for each unit owned by such members. When more than one person holds an interest in any unit, all such persons shall be members. However, a vote for such unit shall be exercised as they determine, but in no event shall more then one vote be cast with respect to any unit. The Declarant shall be entitled to one vote for each unit presently owned by the Declarant.

BY-LAWS

ARTICLE XII

DIGUOLUTION

The Association may be dissolved with the assent given in writing and signed by not less than two-thirds (2/3rds) of the members thereby terminating the condominium pursuant to Florida Statutes 718.117. Upon dissolution of the Association, other than incident to a mergar or consolidation, the assets of the Association shall be dedicated to an appropriate public agency to be used for purposes similar to those for which this Association was created. In the event that such dedication is refused acceptance, such assets shall be granted, conveyed and assigned to any nonprofit corporation, association, trust or other organization to be devoted to such similar purposes.
