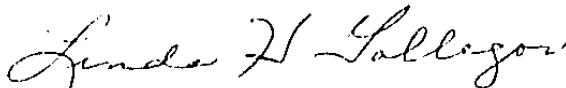

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
CONCILIO DE ORGANIZACIONES HISPANO-AMERICANAS
DE FLORIDA CENTRAL, INC.

We, the undersigned incorporators, hereby associate ourselves and make, subscribe, acknowledge, and file with the Secretary of State of Florida these Articles of Incorporation for the purposes of forming a Not-For-Profit Corporation pursuant to Chapter 617 of the Florida State Statutes.

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of this corporation shall be CONCILIO DE ORGANIZACIONES HISPANO-AMERICANAS DE FLORIDA CENTRAL, INC. hereinafter referred to as the "Council."

ARTICLE II PURPOSES AND OBJECTIVES

The purposes for which this corporation is organized are exclusively charitable, literary, and educational within the meaning of Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.

This corporation shall promote the unification of Hispanic-American organizations, facilitate communication between Hispanic-American organizations and the community, actively participate in community activities, promote awareness of the Hispanic culture, develop community leaders, and advance the civic, economic, social and cultural development of the community.

This organization shall be operated exclusively as a not-for-profit corporation under Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes, using the goals and methods of social work, law, economics, and other disciplines, to secure the advancement of the Hispanic citizens of the United States, and particularly those in Central Florida.

This corporation is organized for the purpose of transacting any or all lawful business for which not-for-profit corporations may be incorporated under Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes as it now exists or may be amended.

The income of the corporation shall not be unreasonably accumulated or invested in such a manner as to jeopardize the carrying out of the purposes of the corporation.

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members, trustees, officers or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth hereinabove.

ARTICLE III - POWERS

This corporation shall be authorized to exercise the powers permitted not-for-profit corporations under Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes, provided that this corporation, in exercising any one or more of such powers, shall do so in furtherance of the exempt purpose for which it has been organized as described in Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 or the corresponding provisions of any subsequent federal tax laws.

ARTICLE IV - MEMBERSHIP

The qualifications for membership and the manner of admission of members shall be regulated by the By-Laws.

ARTICLE V - TERM OF EXISTENCE

The period of duration of this corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE VI - INITIAL REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT

The initial registered office of this corporation shall be One Purlicu Place, Suite 224, Winter Park, FL 32792-4406, and the Registered Agent at that location shall be Linda Hayes Gallegos. The mailing address of the corporation shall be Post Office Box 2947, Orlando, FL 32802.

ARTICLE VII - DIRECTORS

The number of Directors shall initially be seven (7). The number of Directors may be changed by the By-Laws, but shall never be less than seven (7). Directors shall be appointed and hold office in accordance with the By-Laws. The Directors of the corporation must, at all times, be members in good standing of the organizations they represent in the Council.

ARTICLE VIII - MANAGEMENT OF CORPORATION AFFAIRS

The powers of this corporation shall be exercised, its properties controlled, its affairs conducted, and its business managed by an Executive Committee as provided in the By-Laws. The names and addresses of the persons who are to serve as Directors on the initial Executive Committee are:

and/or rescinded by a majority vote of the members of the corporation.

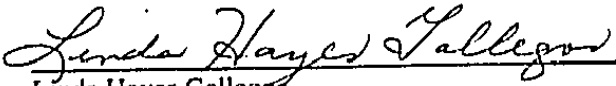
ARTICLE X - DISSOLUTION

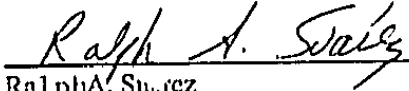

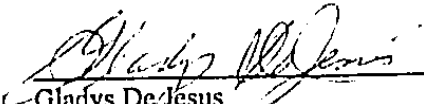
ARTICLE XI - AMENDMENT OF ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

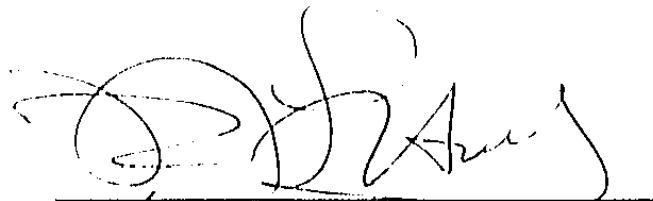

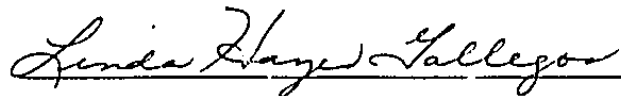
