ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

FOR

DEPARTMENT OF FLORIDA LADIES AUXILIARY TO THE VETERANS OF FOREIGN WARS, INC.

The undersigned subscriber, desiring to form a not for profit corporation under the provisions of Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, does hereby accept all of the rights, privileges, benefits and obligations conferred and imposed by said law and does hereby make, subscribe, acknowledge and file these Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE I

NAME

The name of the corporation shall be DEPARTMENT OF FLORIDA LADIES AUXILIARY TO THE VETERANS OF FOREIGN WARS, INC.

ARTICLE II

CORPORATE PURPOSE

The exclusive objects and purposes of the Corporation shall be to act as an auxiliary to the Department of Florida Veterans of Foreign Wars; to assist needy and disabled war veterans and members of the Armed Forces of the United States and their dependents, and the widows and orphans of deceased veterans; to provide entertainment, care and assistance to hospitalized veterans or members of the Armed Forces of the United States; to carry on programs to perpetuate the memory of deceased veterans and members of the Armed Forces and to comfort their survivors; to conduct

programs for religious, charitable, scientific, literary, or educational purposes; to promote the social welfare; to sponsor or participate in activities of a patriotic nature; and to provide social and recreational activities for members.

ARTICLE III

CORPORATE POWERS

The corporation shall have all corporate powers provided by law and in furtherance of the objectives described above, but shall not have the power to own or hold real property or any interest therein. This corporation shall be and at all times remain under the jurisdiction of the National Convention, National President, and National Council of Administration of the Ladies Auxiliary to the Veterans of Foreign Wars of the United States, the Commander-in-Chief of the Veterans of Foreign Wars of the United States, and subject to the Bylaws and Rules and Regulations of the Ladies Auxiliary to the Veterans of Foreign Wars of the United States and the Charter, Bylaws, and Manual of Procedure of the Veterans of Foreign Wars of the United States.

ARTICLE IV

MEMBERSHIP

The membership of this corporation and the rights and obligations of the members shall be as fixed by the Bylaws; provided, however, that the active and voting membership of this corporation shall at all times be confined to the active membership

in good standing of the Ladies Auxiliary to the Department of Florida Veterans of Foreign Wars of the United States.

ARTICLE V

DURATION

The Corporation shall have perpetual existence commencing with the filing of these Articles by the Secretary of State of Florida.

ARTICLE VI

MANAGEMENT

<u>Section 1</u>. The affairs of the Corporation shall be managed by a Board of Directors, to be known as the Council of Administration, which shall be elected or appointed as provided in the Bylaws. The number, terms, and qualifications of the members of the Council of Administration shall be fixed by the Bylaws. There shall never be fewer than three (3) members of the Council of Administration.

Section 2. The officers of the Corporation shall be a President, a Senior Vice President, a Junior Vice President, a Secretary, a Treasurer, and such other officers as may be required or permitted by the Bylaws. The officers shall be elected or appointed and shall hold office in the manner provided in the Bylaws.

ARTICLE VIII

GENERAL

This corporation shall be and shall at all time remain under the jurisdiction of the National Convention, National President, and National Council of Administration of the Ladies Auxiliary to the Veterans of Foreign Wars of the United States, and the Department of Florida, Veterans of Foreign Wars of the United States, and subject to the Bylaws and Rules and Regulations of the Ladies Auxiliary to the Veterans of Foreign Wars of the United States and the Charter, Bylaws, and Manual of Procedure of the Veterans of Foreign Wars of the United States of Foreign Wars of the United States.

All income and assets of the Corporation in excess of necessary expenses shall be administered solely and exclusively for the purposes of the corporation set forth above.

The Corporation shall have no capital stock and shall pay no dividends to its incorporator, directors, officers, or members. In

addition, no part of the income of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of any private shareholder or individual, or be distributed to its incorporator, directors, officers, or members, provided that the Corporation may pay compensation in a reasonable amount to its incorporator, directors, officers or members for services rendered and may confer benefits upon its members in conformity with its purposes. The private property of the incorporators, directors, officers, or members shall not be liable for the debts of the Corporation.

ARTICLE IX

PRINCIPAL OFFICE, REGISTERED OFFICE AND REGISTERED AGENT

- (a) The principal office address and the mailing address of the Corporation are 420 Howard Avenue, Lakeland, Florida 33801.
- (b) The Corporation's Registered Office is located at 501 East Kennedy Blvd., Suite 1400, Tampa, Florida 33602, and Geoffrey Todd Hodges is hereby appointed as Registered Agent of the Corporation, to accept service of process within this State, to serve in such capacity until a successor is selected and duly designated.

ARTICLE X

DEDICATION OF ASSETS

The Corporation dedicates all assets which it may acquire to the corporate purpose set forth in Article II hereof. In the event that the Corporation shall dissolve or otherwise terminate its corporate existence or shall forfeit its Charter, subject to the provisions of Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, the Corporation shall distribute all of its existing assets to one or more successor organizations created to perform the same functions and with the same purposes as the Corporation or, if none, to the Ladies Auxiliary to the Veterans of Foreign Wars of the United States. None of the assets will be distributed to any officer, director, or member of this Corporation.
